## CHETWYND PEEWEE'S GOING TO PROVINCIALS



I sat down last week with the Chetwynd Giants PeeWee Team Manager Joanne Ruppenthal and team fundraiser Juanita Deck to discuss the Chetwynd PeeWee Hockey teams upcoming Provincial Tournament. The week long tournament will take place in Fernie, BC in mid March. BC Minor Hockey keeps track of scoring and sends only the top teams to provincials. The Giants will be the only APL (All Peace League) Tier 4 Northern team to qualify for Provincials, so this is a pretty big deal for these 12 and 13 years old kids.

The team and parents are in the midst of holding several fundraisers in order to take some of the financial burden off of the parents. The expected costs for each family to attend the tournament for a week will be upwards of \$2500 for food, hotel and fuel. They will be holding basket raffles and gas card raffles. On February 11th they also plan to have a hotdog sale at Super Valu and movie later that day at the Rex Theatre.

This will most likely be the only chance these grade 6 and 7 kids will get to go to Provincials for hockey, as Bantam registration for next year is not anticipated to have high enough numbers to even make a team.

If you see these kids and their dedicated parents selling hotdogs on the 11th, be sure to stop in and buy a hotdog and a movie ticket to help support these kids going to Provincials in Fernie next month.

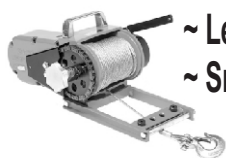

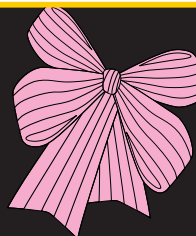

## Revised Mandatory Building Permit Area

In 2016 the electoral area directors consulted with their residents by various means (roundtable meetings in the community, telephone calls, and face-to-face discussions) regarding opinions about the mandatory building permit area of Building Bylaw No. 2131, 2014. Municipalities were also consulted regarding their interests, particularly those municipalities who provide rural fire protection service.

On January 12, 2017 the Board authorized the 1st Reading of Building Bylaw No. 2131, 2014 Amendment Bylaw No. 2279, 2017. The Board will consider 2nd & 3rd Readings and Adoption of Building Bylaw No. 2131, 2014 Amendment Bylaw No. 2279, 2017. On February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017.

### Summarized Changes

Electoral Area 'B'	Reduced to include only that area which is included in the Charlie Lake Fire Protection area.
Electoral Area 'C'	No change to existing mandatory building permit area which includes the full electoral area.
Electoral Area 'D'	Reduced to the Dawson Creek, Pouce Coupe and Taylor rural fire protection areas and to a small area around the Swan Lake subdivision.
Electoral Area 'E'	Reduced to the Chetwynd rural fire protection area and the Moberly Lake fire protection area.

Residents can still access the building permit program upon request, even if they are not in a mandatory area. Such requests in the voluntary area must be made before any construction starts because inspections cannot be provided for work that has been covered over. Residents not in a mandatory area that are building or adding on to a structure may want to check with their lending agency if it is a requirement to have a building permit, final inspection or occupancy permit.

Residents will still have the responsibility to check zoning requirements when building or adding on to structures, because all regulations regarding permitted uses and siting remain unchanged and in force.

"Thank you to the residents who took the time to confer with the electoral area directors on this matter." Vice Chair Rose went on to say "Residents can still access the building permit program even if they are not in a mandatory area."

## INCREASED BC PARKS FUNDING TO PROVIDE MORE RANGERS, STRENGTHEN CONSERVATION

The Province will increase and strengthen conservation in its world-renowned parks with a new investment of \$35 million over the next three years. The funding will result in approximately 25 more full-time park rangers, new programs to promote and protect the natural environment, as well as an initial endowment for a new BC Parks Foundation. \$25 million will go directly to BC Parks operations allowing for new park rangers throughout the province, with a focus on protecting and preserving the backcountry. The increase in full -time rangers is in addition to the seasonal ranger program where 87 temporary positions are filled during the peak demand season. Park ranger duties vary from maintaining trails and campsites, to monitoring wildlife habitats and species at risk, to ensuring guests are aware of risks posed by dangerous animals such as bears and cougars.

The remaining \$10 million will be an initial endowment to the new BC Parks Foundation. The Foundation will help generate private revenue, to be spent on promoting and enhancing the experience in BC Parks.

**Other conservation initiatives arising from increased operations funding will include:**

- A Discover BC Parks program where the public can be engaged through interactive mobile learning spaces, mobile apps, online activities and projects for children, and volunteer-led outreach programs.

- Opening parks to universities and climate-related agencies as living laboratories, to measure and monitor the impact of climate change on ecosystems and wildlife. This, in turn, will help ensure provincial policies and programs are making a difference.

- Enhancing community and volunteer involvement through new community liaison rangers, who will establish relationships and partnerships throughout the province with local governments, community groups, businesses, advocacy organizations, school groups, and the public at large.

BC Parks would also like to invite First Nations communities and Aboriginal groups to express their culture and heritage through BC Parks, and in so doing share their perspectives on nature and history to the broader community. Parks and recreational facilities can serve as the stage to help promote Indigenous culture, to honour First Nations history and the spiritual importance of their ancestral lands.

The increased budget is part of the BC Parks Future Strategy, announced by Premier Christy Clark on Nov. 28, 2016. In addition to the budget increase the Province is investing \$22.9 million to build 1,900 new campsites in provincial parks and recreation sites, incorporating accessible design standards and, most recently, launched a series of licence plates depicting scenes from B.C.'s parks and recreation areas.
