CHETWYND COUNCIL MEETING

There was a regular council meeting held on the afternoon of October 17th. It began with the only presentation of the meeting from Tyria Plamondon of the Chetwynd Visitor Centre with a service report for 2016. Total visitors to the centre are up significantly from last year, with more than 4800 people visiting between April and September of this year. They launched a pilot project this year called Info-On-The-Go where they increased their visitor/local touch point by 88% through walk and bike tours across the community while making connections with people.

The Chetwynd Visitor Centre also held 9 World Host Fundamentals Workshops with 45 people who attended. Tyria will continue to offer the workshops throughout the fall and winter, with the next workshop scheduled for Wednesday, November 16.

The Visitors Centre's Imagine Chetwynd was supported by the Northern Health Imagine Grant and received several items:

- 1 tandem, 1 adult and 1 youth bike and helmets
- Walking poles and bear bells
- Fishing rods, ice fishing rods and life jackets
- Soccer balls, volley balls, basketballs, and footballs
- Tennis and badminton racquets
- Snowshoes

All items are available to the public to help people explore and enjoy the outdoor recreation in our community.

Chetwynd Arts Council will occupy the Visitor Centre facility between the end of October until March of next year. The Annual Art Gala and Youth Art Show are just a few of the events the Arts Council will be showcasing throughout the fall and winter.

Tyria finished by mentioning that while social media becomes easier to find what your looking for, the need for face-to-face interaction still has a very strong presence in the tourism industry.





Tim Van Horn, the photographer and creator of To Canada With Love has been busy capturing the essence of what makes Canada the special place we call home. In the past seven years, Tim has traversed the country five times and created an impressive 44,000 portraits from 1045 communities across every province and territory in Canada.

Upon completion of the mosaic he is creating, a total of 54,000 portraits will have been taken and woven together to create an inspirational nationwide touring mobile interactive pavilion on wheels. The portraits, which will encompass the entire side of a tour bus, will create a Canadian flag and will be the largest visual anthropological culture study that Canadians have ever undertaken.

Tim Van Horn is asking for the public's assistance in part two of his project. After 150 inspirational stops across Canada between 2017 and 2018, he anticipates 24,000 more pictures will be captured, eventually creating a Canada 150 mosaic flag that will be unveiled to the public on Canada Day in 2018.

The council received a letter from TLC Thrift store in Chetwynd requesting support from Mayor and Council for their application to Northern Initiative Trust for up to \$10,000 from the BC Hydro GO Fund Grant for the renovations they wish to complete. The thrift store is hoping to renovate the flooring in the store, as well as a two basin kitchen sink and dishwasher. The result would be a new and improved ergonomic working area for volunteers and staff. The council voted in favour of authorizing a letter of support of their Northern Development Initiative Trust Grant for their renovations.

A letter was received by the District of Chetwynd regarding the Canada Post Review. This fall, a parliamentary committee will be consulting with Canadians on postal service and the options. The Government expects to announce its decision by spring of 2017. You may be interested to know that the options identified by the task force include major changes to moratorium on post office closures in rural and small towns. It outlines the cost savings that could be achieved by converting to franchises or closing all but the 800 highest yielding offices. Councillor Pfanner suggested the Council make a report recommending against further cuts at Canada Post, which was agreed Kelsey Roberts, reporter Coffee Talk Express

As Halloween approaches, people are getting their pumpkins and thinking about what face or design they will carve this year. It got me thinking, who holds the world record for biggest pumpkin, and how big was it? What other giant veggies have been grown? And what does it take to grow enormous produce?

Growing giant veggies and fruit has been a pass time for many gardeners since the dawn of time. Competitions are held all over the world to showcase gardeners unique and massive produce. With tricks and techniques, these gardeners work to outgrow the competition, some competitors entering the contest every year in the hopes of taking home the title of heaviest or longest vegetable.

The former world record for the biggest pumpkin weighed in at 2,232 lbs and was set by Germany's Beni Meier in 2014. The record was soon broken in 2015 by Belgian Mathias Willemijns, whose 2,623 lb pumpkin took the top prize at the Giant Pumpkin European Championship held in Ludwigsburg, Germany. What goes into growing huge pumpkins? Well for starters, the seeds need to

be planted by April or May, and pollinated no later than June. The perfect weather for growing pumpkins is daytime weather of 25 C and night time temperatures of 15 C. When it comes to watering, these giant beauties require 50 gallons a day.

Other records set for giant veggies and fruit include a sweet potato weighing in at 24.9 lbs, a marrow that was 113 lbs that required two men to carry it to the judging table, a watermelon that tipped the scales at 268 lbs, a 36" long cucumber, and a gnarly looking 19 lb carrot.

One man by the name of John Evans, along with his family, consistently grow massive produce and hold records in several categories. Some of their record breakers include: a 45 lb head of red cabbage, 35 lb head of broccoli, 49 lb stock of celery, and a 42 lb garden beet. The part I find most interesting is that these were all grown an hour north of Anchorage, Alaska. Over the years, John has developed his own fertilizers, bio-catalysts, and growing techniques that would take a whole book to explain. With 40 years of growing experience, he didn't start growing these over night, and a lot of research, trial and error went into his feat.

Anything is possible when it comes to growing giant produce, even with the short growing season in this area. It gives me inspiration to attempt growing pumpkins again. My first attempt was more than unsuccessful after the first frost came in the beginning of September and instantly ruined the vine. I suppose all you can do is keep trying and don't be discouraged if the weather doesn't cooperate.
