## Premier John Horgan Speaks At Forum



Last Wednesday, at the BC Natural Resource Forum, Keynote luncheon speaker Premier John Horgan made a speech highlighting some of the challenges the NDP government has encountered. As reported by CKPGToday, Horgan talked about the wildfire seasons and reduction in fiber supply. Horgan also mentioned that current trade disputes with China has placed another challenge on the industry. On a positive note, he noted that the NDP government has still kept the province's financial house in order, including Canada's lowest unemployment rate and maintaining BC's Triple-

A credit rating. As reported by Alaska Highway News, Horgan also spoke about Dam Site C, and is quoted saying "very controversial but fundamental project." He was bullish on the topic on development of LNG, and says the tech sector can bolster mining, forestry, oil and gas, agriculture and more by making them better tools and equipment.

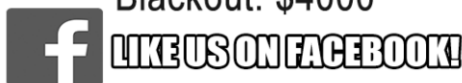

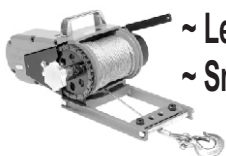
