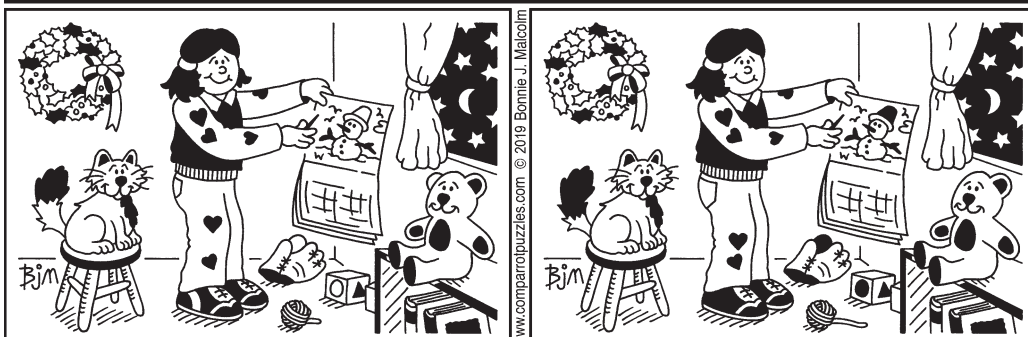

## Stay safe this flu season

The Public Health Agency of Canada's FluWatch report indicates that more than three times as many children have been hospitalized with the flu across the country compared to this time last year.

To date, 281 pediatric hospitalizations have taken place this flu season across the country. 47 of those cases were children under the age of 10 who required admission to the Intensive Care Unit. As of December 15th, 8,245 cases of the flu in both adults and children were confirmed across the country. At this time last year, less than 2,400 cases were confirmed across Canada, and 26 children had been hospitalized.

Additionally, the BC Center for Disease Control advises British Columbians that influenza activity tends to increase around the holiday period every year, and high risk individuals and their close contacts should be vaccinated as soon as possible. They remind the public that high risk individuals include children and people with medical conditions such as heart and lung disease or those with weakened immune systems that make it more difficult to fight respiratory infections.

In addition to vaccination, steps you can take to reduce your own risk and prevent spreading influenza to others include washing hands frequently, avoid contact with your eyes, nose and mouth, coughing and sneezing into your elbow, and remaining at home if you feel unwell.

## BC Hydro Tips On How To Save On Energy Bills

Spokesperson for BC Hydro, Bob Gammer offers some tips for Northerners to ease the burden on Hydro bills during winter and the holidays. He recommends programmable thermostats. If you don't have one, they aren't that expensive and they start paying for themselves in just a couple of years.

Program your thermostat or turn it down when you're at work and turn it up when you're home. 20 degrees is a comfortable temperature. Anything above is a 5 per cent increase on your bill.

Using LED lights for Christmas light displays can make a significant difference. Since people started using them back around 2009 there has been a 40 per cent drop in the amount of power used in outdoor Christmas lights.

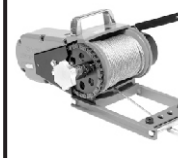
