B.C. JOB FAIRS POSTPONED

Site C job fairs that were planned to have been taking place on July-28-30 in Tumbler Ridge, Fort St. John, and Chetwynd have been postponed until September. The move comes five days after a disturbance was created by an individual at a Site C job fair in Dawson Creek, and another man was shot and killed outside near the event.

In a release posted on the Site C website BC Hydro will be reviewing their policies and procedures for open events. It's noted that the intent is to ensure the safety of staff and the public.

CATEGORY ONE FIRE BAN LIFTED


As of noon Wednesday, July 22nd the campfire ban in the Prince George Fire Center was lifted. Campfires no more than half a meter tall, by half a meter wide will be allowed, as will outdoor stoves and other portable campfire equipment.

Category two and three open burning bans will remain in effect as well the ban on fireworks in the area will stay in place until September 30, or until notified otherwise.



Cheesy Rice Balls

Preparation time: 15 minutes

Ingredients

- 2 tbsp Great Value extra virgin olive oil
 - 1/4 cup plain bread crumbs
- 2 cups cooked and cooled arborio or regular long-grain white rice
 - 1 egg, lightly beaten
 - 1/2 cup finely grated parmesan cheese
 - 1/2 tsp salt
 - 6 small Your Fresh Market mozzarella cubed, each 3/4-inch

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 425°F. Line a baking sheet with foil and drizzle with oil. Spread bread crumbs on a plate and set aside.
- 2. Stir rice with egg, parmesan and salt in a medium bowl. Gather 1/3 cup of rice mixture and form into a ball using wet hands. Tuck a mozzarella cube into the centre, then reshape into a ball.
- 3. Roll each ball through bread crumbs, just enough to lightly coat. Place on foil-lined baking sheet and roll in oil to coat. Repeat with remaining rice, bread crumbs and oil. There will be 6 balls. Bake in centre of oven until golden, about 25 minutes, turning halfway through.


