Chetwynd residents gathered at the Rec Centre on Sunday for the annual Walk for Alzheimer's to raise money, awareness, and honour the memory of loved ones who have suffered with the disease. The event began with a pancake breakfast by donation and a silent auction featuring items donated by local people and businesses. 85% of the funds raised will go to research and education on the illness that currently affects over 747,000 Canadians, with the remaining 15% going back into fundraising efforts. The causes of Alzheimer's are still unknown to researchers and there is currently no cure.

This is the 10th year this event has been held in Chetwynd, which previously was held in January before moving to May this year. Crystal Stewart, Chairperson for the walk in her first year running the event, said that they "are hoping to get more awareness by having it in May instead of January so people don't have to deal with the snow and sleet." Given the sunny, beautiful weather the day featured it is fair to assume the attendees agreed. The walk began at the Rec Centre and then headed to Spirit Park, where people released balloons with the names of loved ones on them as a symbol that their memory lives on.

## **MATT'S MUSINGS**



This Sunday is Mother's Day, and so if you're reading this and haven't got your mom a present yet, there is still time. On Mother's Day we take the time to thank our moms and show our gratitude for everything they've done for us, from giving us life to giving us life lessons. And while this is admirable and should be encouraged, especially given all the little things moms do without us knowing or realizing in our younger years, I would like to see us take another lesson from it: valuing and respecting women all year long. While you may love and respect your mom, particularly on Mother's Day, there's no guarantee that even on Mother's Day she won't have to deal with some of the ugly sexism that women face on a regular basis. The same mother you've loved your entire life has almost certainly at one point been belittled or ignored because of her gender, been paid less for doing the same work as a man, been catcalled or harassed by a man on the street, or had her looks publicly insulted or degraded.

Why do we allow this happen? Quite simply, because we allow it to happen. Whenever a woman is leered at or harassed and we say nothing, we are implying that we are comfortable with this behaviour. Ideally, we would recognize that no human being, regardless of gender, deserves to be treated in such a way, but as we clearly do not we must find ways to make this problem relatable. We all have mothers, and if we were to witness them being treated like this, we would be outraged and rightfully so. Yet when so many women we are not related to suffer this kind of treatment we are silent, denying them their dignity. Children learn by watching, and so many children from abusive homes grow up to be in abusive relationships unless someone breaks the cycle.

While most people are not physically abusive, there are so many other ways that women are made to feel inferior that need to change. If you are a woman, celebrate other women and support them, especially when they face sexism. If you work with women, listen to their ideas and value their contributions equally, don't brush them aside as less serious. If you have a wife, cherish and love her in a way that clearly communicates to your children that you value her as your equal and your partner, not your servant or employee. If you have a daughter, spend the time she needs doing the things she likes to do, don't ignore her because your son has interests more similar to yours. If you have a son, don't instil negative values in him by referring to feminine things as weak or wimpy, as he will internalize those values to the detriment of the women he will encounter throughout his life. And of course, always love, honour and respect your mother, regardless of what day the calendar says it is.



So you think taxes are high? I guess they are. So are the costs of doing business, buying groceries and house repairs, and keeping the municipal water and sewer functions operational. Too bad we don't live in Paradise where the most galling expenditure is to reach the low-hanging fruit. We don't live there but Chetwynd has to be next to that blessed place.

Let me share with you some of the woes of one other real-time small-town BC which we will know as Small Town:

In 2016 the average homeowner in Small Town will pay approximately \$3,396 in taxes thanks to 15 separate levies from local and provincial authorities.

About 40% of the total will help fund authorities like the school district, hospital, library, and Regional District but more than 60% of the total will end up in the coffers of Small Town itself – an increase of 7.6% over last year. I agree that is a huge increase that probably shouldn't have happened all at once.

The spike in the 2016 tax rates in Small Town is the result of three new parcel taxes and a change in the way Small Town collects the policing tax. Why the new parcel taxes? It seems that Small Town's infrastructure is crumbling and in need of significant repairs. Hence, the new general capital renewal tax, water capital renewal tax, and sewer capital renewal tax totaling \$88 per parcel. This on top of existing water capital improvement parcel tax of \$350 and a parcel tax of \$75 for servicing debts from a sewer project completed years ago.

Don't forget that this is Small Town, not much larger than our home town.

The big jump comes from the policing tax that went up by 18.4% in 2016. When Small Town crept over the 5000 threshold in the middle of one dark and stormy night in 2011, its policing costs increased substantially. (Under the Police Act, a municipality must assume responsibility for its police services when, as a result of the Canadian census, its population reaches 5000 people.) But Small Town had a soft-hearted Mayor and Council. They didn't want to see such a heavy additional burden placed on the wallets of their already-taxed citizens. Mayor and Council opted to draw from reserves to cover the additional costs of policing. You know what

happens to your personal reserves when you draw without filling? You do. Same thing in municipal reserves. There's a bottom to every barrel. There comes a time when Mayor and Council have to face the truth. Somebody made a bad decision. Now everybody pays.

The same thing can happen if Councils opt for no cost-of-living increase in taxes. This practice actually amounts to a cut in revenues that cannot be sustained indefinitely. Eventually the tax payers will be hit with major increases in rates.

Chetwynd Council attempts to avoid the mistakes of Small Town through a costof-living increase each year and managing for the major repairs to our also-aging infrastructure.


