

Saulteau First Nations (SFN) is a section 10 band within the meaning of the Indian Act. The Band has been formed by the amalgamation of Dunne - Za, Cree, and Saulteau residents. This First Nations community is covered by Treaty 8. The community is located at the east end of Moberly Lake, which is about 100km southwest of Fort St. John on Highway 29 (25km north of Chetwynd). There is one reserve, East Moberly Lake No.169, spread over 3025.8 hectares.

SFN is currently accepting resumes for the fulltime position of Tenant Relations Officer

Duties include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. The Tenant Relations Officer will assist and report to the Director of Capital Assets & Infrastructure.
- 2. The Tenant Relations Officer is a highly proactive position that is responsible for enhanced liaison and interaction with tenants of SFN housing properties.
- 3. Receive and process applications for Band and Social Housing in order to ensure that applicants are provided with required information and that applications are given due consideration
- Maintain effective relations with all tenants in order to ensure they are aware of their rights and responsibilities concerning Band and Social Housing.
- The Tenant Relations Officer will dedicate the majority of time working directly with tenants and monitoring properties to ensure compliance with Tenancy Agreements. This will include administering and collecting rents in order to ensure that tenants are paying appropriate rental costs according to the SFN Housin Policy each month.
- Maintain administrative procedures in order to ensure an effective and efficient office environment.
- Serving as a community liaison ensuring effective and positive relations between SFN and other agencies and communities.
