

ROTARY MEGA LOTTERY DRAWS WINNERS

Congratulations to Jennifer Katsiris of Fort St. John, the \$25,000 grand prize winner from the 2020 Rotary Mega Lottery draw!

Sherry Cantlon of Fort St. John won the \$10,000 second prize draw, and Deb Wallace of Fort St. John won the \$5,000 third prize draw.

Joe Judge of Dawson Creek won the \$22,380 50-50 draw.

The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles No vehicle shall be left standing or parked: (I) in violation of this bylaw;

(ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with firefighting;

(iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.

Hydrotherapy

The use of water treatments to assist the body in fighting disease has been practiced since ancient times and in several cultures: Egypt, Greece, Rome, China, and Japan. While water is about the only way to adequately cleanse the skin from toxins, it is also a great relaxer. Just looking at a picture of the ocean, I can feel the warm sand under my feet. A person with damaged tissue can rehabilitate more quickly by gravity-reduced exercise in a swimming pool, and weightless freedom limbers arthritic joints. Is there anything more relaxing than a hot tub when winter conditions have chilled you to the bone?

This column is designed to address economical discoveries that will affect your health in a positive way.


While water is both cleansing and relaxing, it has a quality that folks may overlook, and that is the aspect of using contrasting water temperatures for the treatment of infective disease processes. While I do not consider myself an expert, I have both seen and received miraculous results from the proper application of water Alternating hot and cold water treatments will help many conditions by increasing circulation. One caveat though, one should not use this method if there is broken skin, possible appendicitis, or diabetes.

One beneficial therapeutic example is an infected toe which will respond favourably to soaking for 3 minutes in a basin of hot water (heat is gradually increased according to patient's tolerance), and then a 30 second plunge into cold (ice water as tolerated). Each treatment consists of three exchanges in each basin, then a quick dry, (this is where wart or anti-fungal nail treatment would be applied as needed) and then a clean sock. This treatment can be repeated 1-4 times per day until symptoms are alleviated.

Healing requires extra water intake—both of drinking water and the Water of Life (in the form of a prayer) for healing of body, mind, and soul. Wholeness also requires extra rest, spiritually and physically. Going to bed with warm feet induces a relaxed frame of mind and body. Try it!






