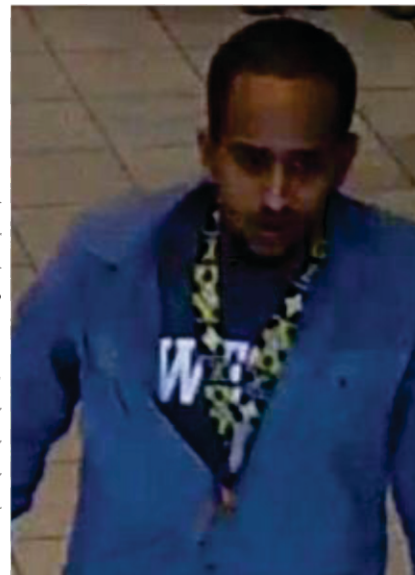
WARRANT ISSUED FOR GRANDE PRAIRIE MALL SHOOTING SUSPECT

Grande Prairie RCMP have identified a suspect in Thursday's Sept 15th mall shooting that injured three people. 23 year old Liban Musse is wanted on an Alberta-wide warrant for multiple firearms offences.

They include reckless discharge of a firearm, discharge of a firearm with intent, possession of a weapon dangerous to the public, carrying a concealed weapon, unauthorized possession of a firearm, and possession of restricted firearm with ammunition.

Musse is described as black, 5'9", roughly 143 pounds with short, dark black hair and brown eyes. He is considered armed and dangerous and residents are warned to not to approach him. If seen, please contact the RCMP.

The cause of the collision is still under investigation by the Fort St John Detachment, in conjunction with the Integrated Collision Analyst/ Reconstructionist Section and the BC Coroner Service.

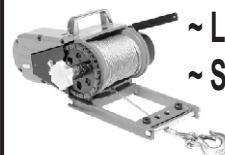
