## February 4th Council Meeting,

On Monday, February 4th, the District of Chetwynd held their first regular council meeting of February with all councillors and the Mayor in attendance.

The Meeting began with a presentation from School District 59's Director of Instruction, Mike Readman and Career Coordinator, Sherry Mounsey. They were there to give an update to the district on the Northern Opportunities and School District 59 Career Programs.

These programs include the "Dual Credit" program, which has 18 different programs available through NLC. There is also a "Trades Sampler" program which lets students spend two weeks exploring 5 different trades. The "WEX" program helps students with internships and work placements that help earn credits for learning in the workplace. And "Youth Work in Trades" is a head start to apprenticeship that helps earn credits toward graduation and helps students apply for scholarships.

Mr. Readman mentioned that there are many programs to suit a wide range of interests. He also mentioned that numbers for these programs have decreased since the discontinuation of the bus service between Chetwynd and Dawson Creek approximately two years ago. Mrs. Mounsey and Mr. Readman both agree that there are more factors that play into the lower numbers of career programs registrants, including the comfort of staying in highschool and graduating with friends.

Mr. Readman went on to give the District some statistics and projections for the next ten years and it is estimated that in the next ten years 41% of students entering the workforce will need trades training.

Northern Opportunities goals are to raise numbers for these incredible programs and help navigate interests of students to help with career pathways. Also they hope to create seamless transitions for students going from school into the workforce.

Over the next few months they will be hosting events across the region to raise awareness and educate students, parents and communities about the local career options that are now available. These events include a Skills Canada Regional Event. Try a Trade at the end of February, the District Career Fair at DCSS, Heavy Equipment Experience and Peace Energy week in May.

The next presentation was from Allie Auger from the Norris-Hoover Memorial Tournament set to take place on March 21st weekend. This will be the committees 10th and final year of the tournament which see teams registering from as far as Manitoba. Hockey players from all ranges of skill and ages ranging from 16-70, this event is a long awaited and anticipated event each year for the hockey community in the area. Miss Auger came to council to not only give the district an update on this years event but to also ask the District to donate \$7000 to the event and become a "Diamond" sponsor their final year. The event is expected to cost just under \$60,000, but will economically benefit the town exponentially. Allie and the committee estimate 6000 people to attend the event. The event will also include a concert from Canadian country music singer Charlie Major, which Allie mentioned the 750 tickets for the show sold out in 6 hours.

After the two presentations Mayor and Council moved along to their reports. The end of the council meeting saw two zoning amendment bylaws which will go to a public hearing on February 19th's Council meeting.

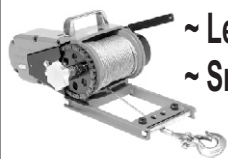

- (iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.
