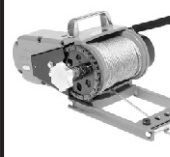

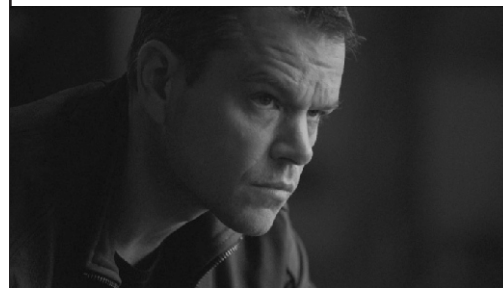

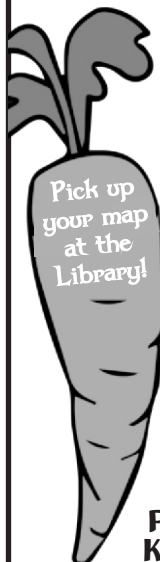

This First Nations community is covered by Treaty 8. The community is located at the east end of Moberly Lake, which is about 100km southwest of Fort St. John on Highway 29 (25km north of Chetwynd). There is one reserve, East Moberly Lake No.169, spread over 3025.8 hectares.

of **Tenant Relations Officer**

Duties include but are not limited to the following:

1. The Tenant Relations Officer will assist and report to the Director of Capital Assets & Infrastructure.
2. The Tenant Relations Officer is a highly proactive position that is responsible for enhanced liaison and interaction with tenants of SFN housing properties.
