about 10 feet away.


"Honey, what's for dinner?"





#### **CHETWYND PRIMARY CARE CLINIC -**

NURSE PRACTITIONER JOINS TEAM, NEW WAYS TO BOOK APPOINTMENTS

a full-time member of the interdisciplinary team at the clinic.

Nurse Practitioners can see patients for acute issues like a cold or injury, follow patients with chronic health issues like diabetes or high blood pressure, provide prenatal care, and do check-ups and physical exams. Nurse Practitioners refer patients to physicians and specialists when appropriate, and can serve as a Primary Health Care Provider.

Kristan's nursing experience encompasses acute and rural settings. For the past eleven years she has worked at the Queen Elizabeth II hospital in Halifax, N.S. and as a travel nurse in northern BC. She gained valuable and comprehensive nursing skills and experience in a variety of disciplines specifically Orthopedics, Vascular and General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Intermediate Care Units and Critical Care Units. In the Intensive Care Unit her specialty was dealing with trauma, medicine, surgery, neurosurgery and the burn unit team.

With the addition of Kristan, the interdisciplinary team will include three physicians and a nurse practitioner. In addition, locum coverage has been secured for the Chetwynd Primary Care Clinic and the emergency department while recruitment efforts continue. Two more full time physicians are expected to join the team after completing the practice ready assessment in February 2016 and the fall of 2016.

The Chetwynd Primary Care Clinic is open Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The clinic also offers community health services including public health, home care nursing, home support, mental health & addictions, audiology, an aboriginal liaison worker and home visiting services such as nutritionist, rehabilitation.

Other health care services available in Chetwynd include:

- · The Chetwynd District Hospital emergency rooms that tend to patients who require urgent medical care.
- · Patients who aren't sure whether their condition would warrant an emergency room visit, or who need health advice can call **HealthLink BC (8-1-1), or visit** www.HealthLinkBC.ca for non-emergency health information from nurses, dietitians, and pharmacists 24 hours a day, seven days per week.

Chetwynd is one of the first communities in B.C. to welcome the community paramedicine program being introduced by BC Emergency Health Services (BCEHS). Under the program, qualified paramedics will take on an expanded role in delivering some primary care services. The program is in the initial stage, during which BCEHS paramedic unit chiefs are helping to confirm the specific services required in the community, for which community paramedics, given their training, are able to provide. It is expected that community paramedics will be delivering community health services in the initial communities in the fall of 2015.

Northern Health would like to thank the physicians, the nurse practitioners, the health care team, and the community of Chetwynd for their support. Northern Health will continue to work collaboratively with local physicians, the District of Chetwynd and the province to recruit physicians to Chetwynd.
