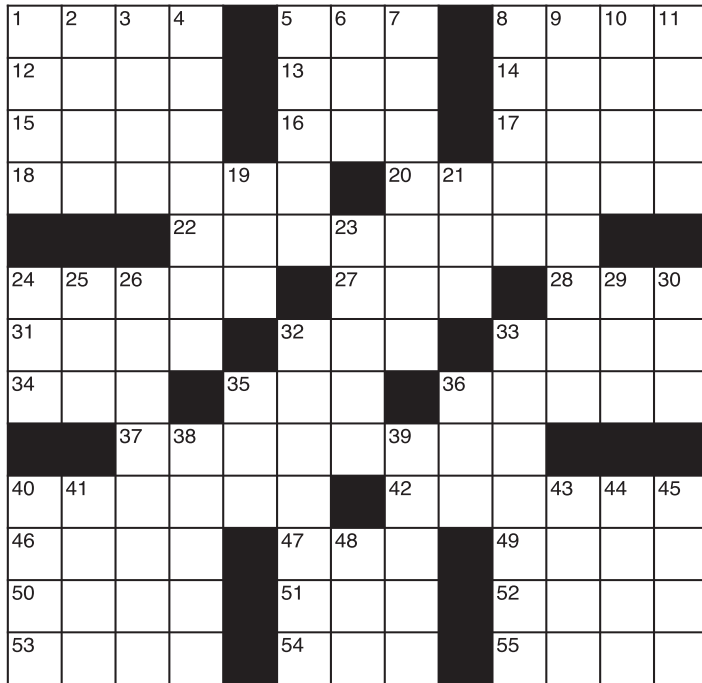

## JOINT STATEMENT ON B.C.'S COVID-19 RESPONSE, LATEST UPDATES

Released October 30, 2020

Dr. Bonnie Henry, B.C.'s provincial health officer, and Adrian Dix, Minister of Health, have issued the following joint statement regarding updates on the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) response in British Columbia:

"Today, we are reporting 272 new cases, including five epi-linked cases, for a total of 14,381 cases in British Columbia.

"There are 2,390 active cases of COVID-19 in the province, 6,003 people who are under active public health monitoring as a result of identified exposure to known cases and 11,670 people who tested positive have recovered.

"Currently, 78 individuals are hospitalized with COVID-19, 25 of whom are in intensive care. The remaining people with COVID-19 are recovering at home in self-isolation. Since the start of the pandemic, there have been 4,664 cases of COVID-19 in the Vancouver Coastal Health region, 8,219 in the Fraser Health region, 256 in the Island Health region, 741 in the Interior Health region, 412 in the Northern Health region and 89 cases of people who reside outside of Canada.

"There has been one new COVID-19 related death, for a total of 263 deaths in British Columbia. We offer our condolences to everyone who has lost their loved ones during the COVID-19 pandemic.

"There have been three new health-care facility outbreaks: at Hawthorne Seniors Care Community, CareLife Fleetwood and Queen's Park Hospital unit 3C NMSK 2. The outbreaks at Fort Langley Seniors Community, The Village and Sunset Manor and Good Samaritan Victoria Heights have been declared over. In total, 24 long-term care or assisted-living facilities and two acute-care facilities have active outbreaks.

"There has been one new community outbreak at Suncor Firebag Oil Sands. There continue to be exposure events around the province. Public alerts and notifications are posted on the BC Centre for Disease Control's (BCCDC) website and on all health authorities' websites.

"As we all enjoy Halloween tomorrow, make it about the treats and not the tricks. Respect homes that are choosing not to participate this year and give everyone the space to stay safe, both indoors and outdoors.

"There are many ways to make fun memories this fall. This weekend is a great opportunity to be outside, enjoying the fall foliage and Halloween decorations. Guidelines on how to celebrate safely are available on the BCCDC website. Now is not the time for parties or large gatherings in our homes. Instead, let's spend time with others in a safe way, outside or in venues that have COVID-19 safety plans in place.

"The provincial health officer order limiting the number of people who can visit our home is in effect and surveillance will be increased for the weekend ahead. Let's make this weekend a safe and fun experience by keeping our groups small and by practising our COVID-19 sense.

# Winter Parking on District Roads Information Everyone Should Know



The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles  
No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:  
(I) in violation of this bylaw;  
(ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with firefighting;  
(iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.

## STATEMENT FROM NORTHERN HEALTH

*This statement is in response to 2 questions that were asked: (1) Can you give a statement on Dr. Banas's letter printed in the Coffee Talk Express on October 20th? (2) With no regular doctor here in Chetwynd, how can people get their prescriptions filled?*

While NH can't comment on the specific details of physician contracts, I can confirm that in this case, the physician's contract had expired, and we could not come to an agreement on an extended or new contract with Dr. Banas. The contract had expired last year and while contract offers were made, none were accepted.

We are pleased that Dr. Banas will remain in the region and continue to provide primary care services.

Chetwynd continues to have one full time local physician, and locum coverage for the Chetwynd Hospital emergency department. Northern Health is working hard to recruit additional physicians and a nurse practitioner to the community of Chetwynd; we have done wide-ranging advertising for locum clinic coverage, with some success, and incentives are being developed for primary care clinic and emergency department coverage.

With respect to prescription refills, Chetwynd residents have a few options, while ongoing recruitment continues. One is to contact their pharmacy, as they would generally be able to extend the prescription until patients are able to see a primary care provider; appointments with Chetwynd's remaining physician (or covering locums) can still be made by calling the Primary Care Clinic; if the prescription is from Dr. Banas, patients should contact his practice, directly. Virtual appointments may also be an option with care providers in Tumbler Ridge or Dawson Creek, and can be explored by contacting the Chetwynd Clinic.

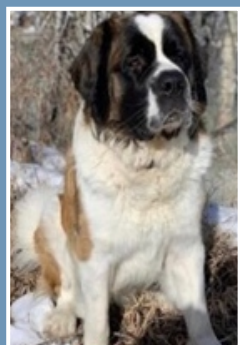

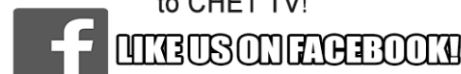
