CIBC PUBLIC MEETING DISCUSSING CLOSURE

Over 30 Chetwynd CIBC customers gathered at the Pomeroy Hotel on May 3rd to discuss the future closing of the town's branch, scheduled for September 9th. Representatives from CIBC were on hand to answer questions and address concerns that people had about the loss of their long-time bank, which originally opened in 1956. Senior Manager of Stakeholder Communications Jon Kastikainen solemnly laid out the situation for the less-than-receptive crowd who wanted answers as to why this closure was necessary. Chetwynd resident Jere Franklin commented that leaving the town in such a manner creates a "public relations nightmare" and "creates heartache and pain" in the community, especially given that there will be no ATM left in the town by CIBC, requiring customers to travel to Dawson Creek to withdraw cash. Regarding the ATM, Kastikainen said putting in a machine in a town where the branch has left "is like opening old wounds" and did not think the bank would change its mind on the matter.


Emotions were high as customers explained what the loss of the branch meant to them, recalling the high level of customer service they received and the personal connection they felt with the bank's staff. One attendee asked about the possibility of reducing hours or keeping the branch open 3 days a week to account for lower business volumes but not leave people without a bank but Kastikainen replied that the bank examines lots of different models when a branch is struggling and ultimately the decision was made to close the branch entirely.

Chetwynd resident Jeff Hecker gave an emotional statement explaining his personal history with the bank, having started his first account at the age of 15, having walked over from the Canfor mill to the branch with his first-ever paycheque. He has been a lifelong, loyal customer, but he questioned why he should continue to pay interest and fees to have to travel to Dawson Creek when the bank is offering nothing to the community. He also mentioned the inconvenience to his elderly father, who is unable to drive and not used to the online banking CIBC is suggesting clients use instead. Upon completing his statement, applause broke out from the audience, as it did again when another attendee noted that the biggest loss was, in her opinion, the strong customer service the bank provided.

Others pointed out that by making people travel to Dawson Creek, they are more likely to stop at Wal-Mart or pick up groceries there, which only further hurts local businesses. One distraught attendee noted that "we haven't been consulted about this," and that it felt like the bank "wasn't aware of the impact on the community." Kastikainen said the bank "highly encourages clients to sit down with our staff between now and September to look at options that make sense for them," but it didn't seem as though most of the available options worked for most of the gathered crowd. One attendee asked about the possibility of CIBC working with other local banks to provide clients cash without charging them fees but was told that would not be an option. All that was offered by way of compensation for disgruntled clients was the promise of a free safety deposit box for 1 year at the Dawson Creek branch.

Ajay Lam, branch manager at the Dawson Creek branch, said that emails were sent to the Chetwynd staff letting them know there may be positions available in Dawson Creek and Fort St. John but currently nothing is confirmed regarding the status of the current employees. This did little to alleviate concerns from the audience regarding the future of the employees, who they noted "are not just workers, they're part of our community." CHET TV General Manager Leo Sabulsky inquired as to what will happen to the building, which the bank currently owns, as well as the furniture once the bank closes and asked if the building could be donated to local community groups in need, which Kastikainen said they would consider. The event closed with Jere Franklin outlining a plan to work with the community and attempt to save the bank, which he said would create positive public relations ripples in contrast with the negative ones associated with closing the branch. He was thanked for his contribution but it did not appear that the bank was receptive to his ideas. Barring a dramatic intervention, on September 10th the only remaining banks in town will be Scotiabank, Lake View Credit Union, and TD Canada Trust.
