Saulteau First Nations (SFN) is a section 10 band within the meaning of the Indian Act. The Band has been formed by the amalgamation of Dunne - Za, Cree, and Saulteau residents. This First Nations community is covered by Treaty 8. The community is located at the east end of Moberly Lake, which is about 100km southwest of Fort St. John on Highway 29. There is one reserve, East Moberly Lake No.169, spread over 3025.8 hectares.

SFN is currently accepting resumes for Farming Manager

The Manager of Farms is primarily responsible for administration within the farm lands and maintaining records to ensure that Saulteau First Nations farm land and assets are used in an appropriate manner.

The Manager of Farm reports to the Director of Operations and is responsible for maintaining record and land use plans, providing technical knowledge to labor force in the up keep, productivity and cropping for the SFN lands designated for farming operation.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain records of farm, assets, inventory, land use information, and plans
- Supervision of all dept staff
- Positive leadership
- Assist Director of Operations with the development of the SFN Operational Budget and to monitor and be accountable for all program and service expenditures
- To monitor and complete appropriate reporting to funders
- To advise the Director about programs and policies appropriate to the mandate of the farm
- To be an active participant of the SFN management team, attending meetings and bringing forward discussion and decision
- To participate on key committees as appointed by Director
- Participate in all SFN sponsored community events and/or designate staff

Qualifications

- Extensive diversified farming experience in farm related operations, other related resource management discipline, and a minimum of two years management experience
- Previous experience working with First Nations, farming operations, government, (sheep, cattle, horses, hay, crops)
- Knowledge and experience in planning, budgeting and supervising
- Experience and knowledge implementing policy and procedures
- Have excellent oral and written communication skills, plus strong negotiation skills
- Ability to solve problems, make effective decisions, resolve conflicts and manage time effectively
