Rally Held In Grande Prairie Sunday In Support Of Alberta Oil Industry

The rest of Canada needs to be thankful for the prosperity the oil industry in Alberta provides. That was the message delivered to the hundreds that turned out at a rally in Grande Prairie in support of the industry.

Alaska Highway News Reports speaker Bernie Hancock says the oil industry is not a monumental cash cow for the government. It provides opportunities for families across the country.

He added, "It puts chicken in the pot in New Glasgow Nova Scotia. It puts roast in the oven in Miramichi, New Brunswick.

The oil industry has been struggling with a price differential that's due in part to lack of capacity to transport oil to markets. Grande Prairie and the rest of Alberta has felt the crunch. Oilfield Dads and Rally4Resources organized the event in Grande Prairie yesterday. They say government regulations are suffocating the Canadian oil and gas industry.

My Prince George Now reports Prince George police have received a number of tips from different communities in the disappearance of 17 year old Colin Therrin Fleury but have so far come up empty.

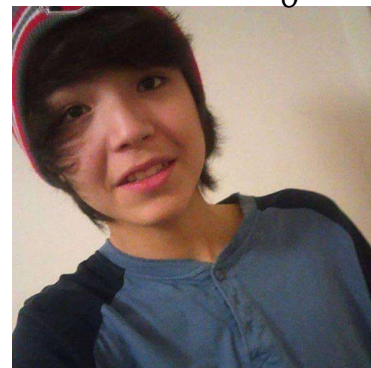
Colin Fleury was last seen May 3 and was reported missing the following day by family and friends.

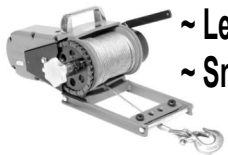

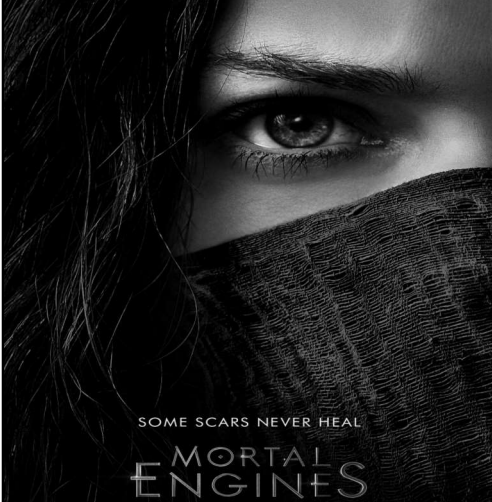

Message from Saulteau First Nations on Caribou Recovery

There used to be thousands and thousands of caribou in the Peace Region. Now there are less than a few hundred left, and their populations have been declining fast. The federal government has responsibility for endangered species under the Species at Risk Act. In May, after years of study, the federal government determined that there is what they call an “imminent threat” to caribou recovery in BC. That means that the provincial government must take steps to support caribou recovery, not for First Nations but for all Canadians.

The federal and provincial governments started talking to us about caribou recovery for two main reasons. First, because we have a lot of knowledge and experience. Over the past four years, together with West Moberly and wildlife experts, we took a herd that was down to 16 animals, and we have slowly brought it back up to about 80 and growing. That is the most successful caribou recovery program ever, anywhere in the world, and we would like the people in the Peace to be proud of that.

The other reason they are talking to us is because we have constitutional rights to hunt and manage the caribou herds. Some people might think that’s not fair, but we ask you to remember that is not our law, that is Canada’s law. Our legal systems are different. (Under our law, we banned our people from hunting caribou decades ago for conservation reasons.)

We don’t want the caribou to go extinct, we do want the herds to recover. We live in a big country and think there is room for caribou and for people. And we think that caribou recovery will be good for us, and for everyone in the Peace, and in BC and Canada.

Now we know that there are a lot of rumors going around about the steps that the federal and provincial governments are thinking of taking to help recover caribou. We understand that people in the Peace Region are concerned, We understand that because we are Peace people also. We love the outdoors. We work here, and our people share a lot of the same values that you do. We are your neighbors and we all share the Treaty 8 and Peace Region together.

Here are the facts as we understand them: The steps that the federal and provincial governments are thinking of taking are not going to cause mills to shut down. That is just not true. Powder King is not getting shut down. There will not be a ban on river boating. They are not going to restrict recreational access to the bush. There may be some motor vehicle closures in some high alpine areas, but only when and where those activities pose a real threat to endangered caribou herds. There will still be lots of deep snow to ride in. And there will also still be mining, and forestry, and gas and pipelines, and other industries. We are part of the economy in the Peace too, and we don’t want to see economic development stop either.

There is also going to be lots of consultation with local stakeholders, companies and municipalities in the New Year. There will be lots of time for information sharing and discussions.

It would be better to be patient and have some faith. When people jump the gun and give into their worst fears and spread wild rumors, based on false information - it doesn’t help their cause, it actually makes it less likely that governments will listen to them.

We have faith that what we all want is to find the right balance between protection for the things we all love about the Peace - mountains, wildlife, the rivers - and the things that we all need - economic development, recreation, hospitals, schools, safe highways, and so on.

We want to get involved in the discussions when the consultation process begins next year, and to participate in a way that is informed, calm, respectful, fair and reasonable. We think that is the best way forward and we hope that you will agree.

In the meantime, we wish everyone in the Peace the best for Christmas and the New Year.
