### 7 WAYS TO GET INVOLVED IN LOCAL POLITICS AND PROTECT DEMOCRACY



Many of us are increasingly dismayed by the erosion of democracy. Sometimes we don't realize what has happened until it's too late and that's a little like closing the barn door after the cows have escaped. Sometimes it can feel that we have little power, and perhaps on a large scale, that is true. But where citizens can truly have an impact is at the grassroots level, when voting for local representatives. Yet turnout at municipal elections is rarely above 50 per cent, much lower than at provincial or federal levels.

So here are some ways to get involved and make a difference: Find out who your local alder(wo)man or councillor is and find out how to get in touch with them. Attend local council meetings in order to know what decisions are being made. You can have an impact because these actions usually affect you directly. Join a local community group — there are many that advocate everything from saving green spaces to feeding the hungry. Then push local politicians to support your work. During an election year (municipal elections are held every four years in the fall) get involved in a campaign and support a candidate whose ideas align with yours. You will get to know the issues, and your y o u neighbours, a s q o door-to-door. Subscribe to several newspapers or online publications; this supports journalism, which is important to democracy and keeps you informed.

Vote. This is a privilege that not everyone in the world enjoys. Don't waste your voice as every vote counts.

And finally, stay involved when the election is over.

### THANKSGIVING HACKS YOU'LL BE GRATEFUL FOR



This holiday is all about spending time with family and friends. But that can be a tough thing to do if you're stuck in the kitchen. This Thanksgiving, entertaining expert Pay Chen is sharing her tips on getting you out from in front of the stove and into a comfortable seat at the dining room table.

After about four hours on high, mash them right in the slow cooker with some warm milk and butter."

Pre-cut your vegetables. Chopping vegetables in advance will save you a lot of time on the big day, says Chen. If you're really strapped for time, grocery stores also offer pre-cut and pre-washed vegetables, although these are often at a higher price point.

Consider a pre-made dessert. Dessert is the finish line of the meal, and there's nothing better than a little assist to bring it home. "If you're running low on time, consider picking up a quick and delicious frozen dessert," says Chen. "Just make sure it's a top-quality option that matches the made-from-scratch spirit of the meal." ### **ELECTOR REGISTRATION**

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the District of Chetwynd for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

**Resident electors** must produce **2** pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

**To register, non-resident property electors** must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of the property owners.

The most important challenges facing out community are financing continual infrastructure upgrades, retaining health care professionals, private sector employee recruitment and taxes.









