

# 3 bad habits that will amp up your energy bills

Many homeowners are surprised to learn how much energy their electronic devices use. If you're looking for ways to conserve energy and spend less on your utility bills, here are three habits that you should break immediately.

- Watching television and movies on gaming consoles. Video game consoles use 30 to 45 per cent more power than televisions. In addition, running one high-definition gaming console requires the equivalent amount of energy as running 10 Blu-Ray devices. You're better off using your console for nothing but gaming.
- Leaving your electronics plugged in all the time. This is a common habit, but did you know that many electronic devices use up to 40 per cent

of the energy required for their functioning, even when they're turned off?

Unplugging your toaster and coffee maker after breakfast and removing chargers from outlets once devices are charged will help you conserve energy.

3. Not thinking through purchases. Laser printers use nearly twice as much power as inkjet versions. Before buying one, ask yourself if the increase in energy consumption over traditional models is worth it.

Similarly, a 55-inch flat-screen TV uses twice as much energy as a 32-inch model. Consider whether the upgrade in size is worth it.

The bottom line is that you should evaluate your needs and make purchasing decisions accordingly.

In sum, to save energy at home you should evaluate what electronics you use and how you use them. Doing so will allow you to save on your utility bills and may even extend the lifespan of your devices.



#### SETTINGS

Televisions, computers, printers and various other devices may sometimes come equipped with a "sleep," "power saving" or "standby" feature. You can reduce power usage in your home by engaging this function when the item isn't in use. In addition, you can change some settings, such as screen brightness, to improve energy efficiency of the device.

Give your guests this sweet honey and zesty ginger holiday punch as soon as they enter the party. It's a warming and fragrant holiday season sipper, made refreshing with thirstquenching lemonade, ice-cold citrus slices and an effervescent hit of de-alcoholized wine, which can be substituted with sparkling wine if you prefer an adults-only version.

Sparkling Citrus Ginger Punch

Prep time: 5 minutes Cool/chill time: 1 hour, 15 minutes Serves: 10

Ingredients:

1/4 cup (60 mL) honey 4 cups (1 L) ginger beer

3½ cups (875 mL) PC honey ginger lemonade 1½ cups (375 mL) white de-alcoholized wine, chilled 3 cups (750 mL) ice cubes

10 slices frozen citrus blend sliced lemons and limes ¼ cup (60 mL) frozen cranberries (optional)

Directions:

Stir honey with 1 cup boiling water in small heatproof bowl until combined. Let cool completely, about 15 minutes.

Stir together ginger beer, lemonade and honey mixture in punch bowl or 12-cup (3 L) pitcher. Refrigerate until chilled, about 1 hour.

Stir in de-alcoholized wine. Add ice cubes, lemon and lime slices and cranberries (if using). Serve immediately.



Word of mouth shouldn't be underestimated but having a website will allow you to reach clients in other cities and regions. This is especially relevant if you have an online store.


#### 4. Get free market research
