## April's Second Council Meeting

The second Council Meeting of April was held this past Monday, April 15th in the council chambers. All councillors were in attendance with the exception of Laura Weisgerber who joined the meeting via conference call.


Before the meeting, delegate Kelly McTaggart from the Canadian oil and natural gas producers (CAPP) gave a presentation. The presentation was to update Mayor and council on current standing and projects. CAPP produces 80% of Canada's natural gas and crude oil. They showed a slide of projective statistics of the growth in the global energy sector from 2016-2040, which showed an increase in almost all areas, excluding coal which stayed approximately the same throughout the 24 year period. CAPP has seen slight dips in recent years in "Upstream Capital Investments" and a dip in number of wells drilled in Western Canada. Current issues CAPP faces include LNG, Caribou, Land use planning Bill C-69 and Bill C-48.

Council went ahead to give the first, second and third readings to the zoning amendment bylaw discussed in a previous meeting. They also went ahead to read the financial plan for years 2019-2023 as well as the levying of tax rates for municipal, hospital, and regional district purposes for 2019.

Mayor and council moved along to authorize members of council to attend a meeting with Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy and the District of Tumbler Ridge at Gwillim Lake Park Tuesday, May 21, 2019.

Mayor and council authorized that a public hearing be held to gather input regarding the rezoning for sale of civic property at 5000 and 5040 North Access Rd. (Empty lot beside new Lakeview Credit Union in Chetwynd) Plans for construction are in the works for some new retail spaces. The public input period will be held May 21, 2019 at 4:30pm.

The last item was an application for a development permit for a new storage building at

Treaty 8 First Nations involved in caribou recovery efforts in the South Peace hope to stem the spread of misinformation. As reported by Alaska Highway News, West Moberly Chief Roland Willson and Saulteau Chief Ken Cameron met with Premier John Horgan and Forests Minster Doug Donaldson in Dawson Creek on Monday. In a press release the next day, the chiefs said Lekstrom will be instrumental in dispelling myths about the agreement and addressing the racist attitudes found in some commentary about the issue on social media. Wilson said there will be no restrictions on activities like hiking, hunting, fishing and camping.


