# BRUSHING UP ON YOUR ABCS OF HEALTH THIS MONTH

Time to update your knowledge about health conditions that may be relevant to your life.

An important one you may not have considered is hepatitis. There are three common forms -A, B and C — that affect thousands of Canadians each year, resulting in short-term illnesses and life-threatening consequences. Here's what you need to know:

A: Hepatitis A is spread through close contact with an infected person, or by consuming contaminated food or drinking water. This can occur if you have or will travel to regions where the condition is common, like the Caribbean and South America.

B: Hepatitis B is common worldwide. Some ways you can risk exposure include getting tattoos, piercings, pedicures, manicures or medical procedures with improperly sterilized equipment, sharing personal hygiene items or having unprotected sex with an infected person.

C: This liver disease is caused by a virus that attacks the liver without warning and puts individuals at risk of developing complications including cirrhosis, liver cancer and ultimately death from liver failure. The Canadian Association for the Study of the Liver recommends that Canadians get tested based on their age, not just risk factors. The hepatitis C antibody test is a simple blood test covered by all provincial healthcare plans.

Getting vaccinated for hepatitis A and B is a great way to prevent it, however there is no vaccine for hepatitis C. In order to determine if you might have hepatitis C, there is a simple blood test your doctor can recommend.

To find out your hepatitis risk, complete the Canadian Liver Foundation's viral

hepatitis questionnaire at liver.ca/hepatitisquestionnaire.



# KELSEY'S CHRONICLE



I love a good thunderstorm! After all the lightning storms we have had in the past month I thought I would find out some more about the fascinating bolts and sheets of lightning that have been filling our

These electrical discharges are caused by an imbalance between the clouds and the ground or within the clouds themselves. Most often the lightning stays in the sky and strikes between the clouds. A cloud to ground lightning bolt can heat the surrounding air to temperatures 5 times hotter than the sun. The heat causes the air to rapidly expand and vibrate causing the thunder sound that booms so loud.

Lightning tends to strike steeples, trees and flag poles and objects alike because the negatively charged storm clouds cause them to become positively charged, acting like a beacon for lightning to strike.

As well as inanimate objects, lighting sometimes strikes people. Around 2000 people die from lightning strikes around the world, each year and hundreds more survive. While many end up with life altering ailments some others have been deemed extremely lucky having walked away from a lightning strike with a positive change to their bodies. A doctor was struck by lightning and suddenly had the urge to play piano and became a world famous concert pianist. Another man regained his sight and hearing after a lightning bolt struck him. Some people who are struck by lightning end up with a sci-fi lightning bolt pattern on their skin. Some call it skin feathering or lightning flowers, but the medical terms are arborescent (tree-like) erythema or keraunographic markings.

Each bolt of lightning can travel of speeds over 300,000km/h during the beginning of its race to earth. But when the bolt gets within 150 feet of a positively charged object. The positive electricity can surge upwards at up to 300,000,000 km/h and contain over 1 billion

The best ways to be safe in a thunder storm is to stay inside, and away from water sources and phone lines. In your car is also a safe zone, not just because of the rubber tires like many assume but because of the combination of the metal frame and the tires which helps harmlessly carry the lightning to the ground. Who knew lightning was so fascinating!




