STUDENT VOTER SURGE CREDITED WITH BOOSTING TURNOUT IN 2015 FEDERAL ELECTION


According to a Statistics Canada post-Federal election report released Monday, February 22, 2016, young Canadians (18-24) turned out in record numbers and helped increase overall voter turnout to the highest level in 25 years.

"The Stats Can report confirms what we saw at campuses across the province during the election: students were interested, students were involved, students wanted to help make a difference," said Simka Marshall, chairperson of the BC Federation of Students.

"Together we sent a powerful message to the skeptics and the cynics: young Canadians do care about being part of the solution and we're stepping forward in record numbers. Don't underestimate this generation," concluded Ms. Marshall.

Comparing the 2011 and 2015 elections, the number of Canadians who reported that they voted increased 12 percentage points among people aged 18 to 24, and 11 percentage points among those aged 25 to 34.


