CANADA PROPOSES CANNABIS ACT

Canada's proposed Cannabis Act will create a strict legal framework to control the production, distribution, sale and possession of cannabis across Canada.

The act that was updated and published earlier this year, seeks to restrict youth access to the substance and to reduce criminal activity by imposing serious criminal penalties for those breaking the laws, especially those who import, export or provide cannabis to youth.

The Cannabis Act aims to protect public health through safety and quality requirements, and reducing the burden on the criminal justice system. Should the Act come into force, adults who are 18 years or older would be legally be able allowed to have 30 grams of legal dried cannabis, or the non-dried equivalent, and buy cannabis from a provincially licensed retailer.







CHETWYND CHAMBER'S APRIL POWER LUNCH

On April 19th, the Chetwynd Chamber of Commerce's Power Lunch hosted key speakers from the NEBC Resource Municipalities Coalition in the Chetwynd's Pomeroy Hotel's conference room. The lunch had a decent turnout for attendance, engaged in learning about the Mayor's Coalition. 3 key members from the coalition were there to speak on its behalf, Lori Ackerman-Mayor of Fort St John, Rob Fraser- Mayor of Taylor and Don McPherson, Mayor of Tumbler Ridge.

Lori Ackerman began by explaining the importance of having a unified voice. The coalition has been working together to create a stronger voice in provincial and federal government for North East British Columbia. Helping protect and enhance BC's sustainable future, while facilitating resource development.

Mr. Fraser mentioned how the power of leverage when working with neighbouring communities can be huge in letting everyone's voice be heard.

Mrs. Ackerman ran through their goals to strongly and aggressively represent the best interests of industry, provincial and federal government and commissions. Additionally to engage First Nations and promote collaboration.

in 2017 the Mayor's Coalition met with Minister Mungall, attended the Coal Forum, met and discussed issues with Premier Horgan at UBCM and, attended the BCNRF, among other important activities.

This year, the plan is to have open meetings with several Ministries, and formally advance the "energy roadmap" energy plan. They also plan to go through the provincial scientific review on hydraulic fracturing and if needed create a position paper from a community perspective. These are just a few of the important happenings set to take place throughout 2018.

Another issue that the coalition spoke about was the interprovincial issues with contractors and PST. This has been an issue for some time and numbers show that only 65% of contractors from Alberta pay BC's PST when performing work in our province. This comes down to lack of enforcement, lack of education and legislature could be better, Mr. Fraser says. He mentioned that they have looked to Saskatchewan for a possible solution. Saskatchewan makes Alberta contractors register, put up a bond in the amount of the PST and asks for a letter from WCB proving the funds have been paid. Fraser mentioned that when Christy Clark was Premier of BC they were very close to seeing it on legislature. It's off the agenda now because of the other issues at hand, but will hopefully make an appearance again very soon.

The group held a forum in Fort St John hoping to hear the concerns of the community and the turnout was phenomenal. 118 people attended and they collected 22 pages of notes that broke down into themes that will be presented in a report to Minister Mungall. Some of the themes include putting a global lens on climate impacts, looking at the carbon policy impact, incentivizing innovation, reliable and accurate scientific measurements and many more issues important to North East BC. Another topic the Mayors discussed was the Kinder Morgan project that has seen its fair share of scrutiny from our Premier and protestors in the past few months and has now been put on suspension for all non essential work. A letter was circulated to the communities throughout BC asking to support Premier John Horgan's decision to stop the pipeline. The Mayor's Coalition, although in support of the Kinder Morgan project liked the spirit of the letter but not the specific wording- "obstructionist behaviour." The Coalition says they are still open to working with the province on the issue.

Don McPherson finished the meeting by mentioning the "Walk the Talk" award that Tumbler Ridge has given to Conuma Coal for delivering on all the promises they made to the community.
