#### CHAMBER OF COMMERCE LUNCHEON

The Chetwynd Chamber of Commerce Luncheon took place today. The meeting was to discuss the Site C Energy Project, which aims to meet future electricity demands in BC.


The first speaker was Dave Conway, Community Relations for the Site C Project for BC Hydro. His presentation highlighted the progress of construction of the dam, which is currently on time and on budget. The dam being built is 60 meters high and water will come up to 50 meters in order to create a thin reservoir that will go back to the Peace Canyon Dam. This dam will have 2-3 days of water supply without new water coming into the reservoir.

Also discussed was the impact to Highway 29. There are 6 sections of the highway, between Bear Flat and Lynch Creek, that need to be realigned, due to either flooding or erosion.

The construction of Site C is expected to have a large economic impact, with \$40 million in tax revenues to the local government, \$179 million in tax revenues to the provincial government, and \$270 million to the federal

The second speaker was Amber Harding, Communications and Stakeholder Relationships Professional for Peace River Hydro Partners. She highlighted the procurement procedures for this project and how this project can increase opportunities for local businesses. She also stressed the importance of hiring locally for this project.

BREAKING POLITICAL BARRIERS

Canada's first First Nations person, and only the

second aboriginal person after Louis Riel, to be elected to a Canadian legislature was Frank Arthur Calder. Born in 1915 at Nass Harbour in northwestern BC. Calder is a member of the

Nisga's and was the first aboriginal person to graduate from the University of British Columbia.

> In 1949, he was elected MLA for the riding of Atlin

and served off and on for 26 years. In 1972, he became Canada's first aboriginal cabinet minister but was dismissed the following year for disagreeing with NDP policy. He joined the Social Credit Party and was re-elected in 1975. His name is widely known because of the controversial Calder

Case, which led to a landmark 1973 Supreme Court

decision that dealt with Nisga's land claims. He was named an officer of the Order of Canada in 1988.



#### MONSTER TRUCK






#### BC TRIVIA

Known as the Spirit of Lekwammen (Land of the Winds), this 55 metre tall totem pole, carved from a single ancient cedar, was raised as part of the opening ceremonies of the 1994 Commonwealth Games held in Victoria. Alas, safety concerns were soon also raised, and fears that an airplane might

eventually crash into it led to the pole being downsized to a 12 metre high mere shadow of its former self. Only slightly shorter than the original Spirit of Lekwammen, at 53 metres, the tallest totem still standing can be found on Alert Bay at the northern end of Vancouver Island. Made of two trees rather than just one, it was carved bу Kwakwaka'wakw artists to represent various tribes of their nation.






