Heat Warning in Effect

Heat Warning in effect for:

B.C. North Peace River

B.C. South Peace River

A dangerous long duration heat wave will affect B.C. until Wednesday, except until Tuesday for northwestern BC. Threat: Daytime highs ranging from 35 to 40 degrees celsius combined with overnight lows near 16 degrees celsius. An exceptionally strong ridge of high pressure is situated over British Columbia and will likely result in record breaking temperatures over the next few days. The duration of this heat wave is concerning as there is little relief at night with elevated overnight temperatures. This record-breaking heat event will increase the potential for heat-related illnesses, raise river levels due to glacier melt and increase the risk of wildfires due to drought conditions.

Drink plenty of water even before you feel thirsty and stay in a cool place.

Check on older family, friends and neighbours. Make sure they are cool and drinking water

Never leave people or pets inside a parked vehicle.

Watch for the symptoms of heat illness: dizziness/fainting; nausea/vomiting; rapid breathing and heartbeat; extreme thirst; decreased urination with unusually dark urine.

Outdoor workers should take regularly scheduled breaks in a cool place.
