
### JACKFISH COMMUNITY MEETS WITH BC HYDRO

BC Hydro held a meeting at the Jackfish Community Centre to discuss some issues surrounding Jackfish Road on May 18, hoping to provide an outlet for inquiries held by the local community. Among the topics discussed were the hauling of rocks from Chetwynd to the Site C dam. People had expressed concerns that hauling the rocks by truck would lead to constant traffic along the road but were told that the rocks will be hauled from Pine Pass by train to a spot where the rock can be unloaded by heavy equipment for use in constructing the dam. Many people raised concerns about the condition of Jackfish Lake Road, particularly with the increased traffic it now sees. BC Hydro said they will monitor the road but at this time they will not be doing any upgrades due to the fact that the rock will not be hauled along the road. They said the cost to upgrade the road is not worth the investment given that the rock will be hauled by train.

Regarding the use of trains to haul the rock, the question was raised as to whether BC Hydro has a contingency plan in place given the history of CN Rail having to deal with shutdowns due to job action. The representative said that no one had ever raised this issue before and would be looking into it. Additionally, people wondered about the prospect of increased wait times at all of Chetwynd's rail crossings, which already can stop traffic for up to 30 minutes at times. Questions about hiring local workers rather than people from Alberta were answered through referrals to the interprovincial agreement held between B.C., Alberta and Saskatchewan that allows a free flow of workers, goods and services. Workers are hired based first on skills and then other considerations such as locality are looked at.

Other suggestions from the crowd included clearing the vegetation in the ditches, especially around corners as well as fixing the highway shoulders so there isn't as much of a drop from the asphalt to the gravel. Another person recommended more signage on the road to improve awareness of conditions and increase safety. Residents were also displeased that large trucks have driven down their side roads and are only able to turn around in their yards, resulting in damage to their yards and driveways. Others requested better maintenance on the highway, on the areas further out where the road is gravel and there has not been any dust reduction chemicals or water applied, which has resulted in hazardous driving conditions. Although the representative was not able to confirm that any of these measures would be taken, they said the concerns would be passed along to the higher-

ups at BC Hydro, which did not appear to satisfy any of the assembled crowd.





### NEW INFORMATION GRANDE PRAIRIE HOME HARDWARE ASSAULT

New information has come to light about the man charged with the second-degree murder of an Abbotsford man in a Grande Prairie parking lot on May 14th.

30 year-old Micheal Ginter was charged with second-degree murder after allegedly side-swiping another vehicle with 34 year-old Nikkolas Steenhuisen on his vehicle's running board. Steenhuisen was attempting to apprehend Ginter after spotting Ginter inside of his truck when he exited the Grande Prairie Home Hardware, and later died of injuries he sustained in the collision.

Cst. Michelle Mosher with the Grande Prairie RCMP confirmed that Ginter was also one of two men convicted of a \$200,000 crime spree back in April of last year. Ginter was sentenced in November 2015 for a break and enter, and possession of stolen property after being caught passed out behind the wheel of a stolen vehicle on April 2nd, 2015. At the time of arrest both Ginter and his co-accused, then 33 year-old Joseph Semple, appeared to be under the influence of methamphetamine, according to RCMP Sgt. Ed Reinink with the Dawson Creek detachment. Ginter was sentenced to 360 days and given credit for 314 days served awaiting trial.






