WATCH FOR DEER: RUTTING SEASON IS HERE

Drivers are advised to be watchful of deer, elk and moose while travelling along roads and highways throughout B.C., as rutting season increases these animals' activity.

Rutting season is the annual mating time for deer, elk and moose. It occurs from late October to December, with the most activity seen in mid-November. During the rut, male deer show increased interest in female deer, as well as increased aggression toward other male deer, often causing animals to move quickly with little regard for their surroundings.


As this season poses an increased risk for deer-vehicle collisions, travellers on B.C. highways are reminded to pay extra attention, especially when driving at dusk, dawn and night hours when these animals are most active.

Tips for avoiding deer-vehicle collisions:

- Be vigilant when driving at peak hours when deer are most active: dawn and dusk. If you see one deer, watch for others, as these animals seldom travel alone.
- Be alert near wooded areas or green spaces, such as tree lines, parks and golf courses, and near water sources, such as lakes, ponds and streams.
- Watch for deer/elk crossing signs and flashing wildlife-warning signs, such as the ones
 recently installed on Highway 18 in Vancouver Island's Cowichan Valley. These signs
 are placed in areas with high numbers of reported deer-vehicle incidents. Heed these
 warnings and adjust travelling speed accordingly.
- Keep your vehicle in good shape make sure headlights, windshields and wipers are clean and in working condition.
- Use high beams at night when there are no oncoming vehicles to scan the road ahead. Honk your horn with one long blast to frighten animals away from your vehicle.



Winter Parking on District Roads Information Everyone Should Know



The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:
(I) in violation of this bylaw;

(ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with firefighting;

(iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.




