MASSIVE MAKER MASHUP, FUN FOR ALL AGES

The "Maker Mobile, Workshop on Wheels" made it's debut appearance in Chetwynd this past Tuesday, hosted by the Library. Kids of all ages were encouraged to participate in several fun and educational activities throughout the day between 10am-4:30pm.

Farrell Segall, Simon Lyons and Jennifer Lyons are the faces of The Maker Mobile, which is a travelling workshop based out of Vancouver. While they have been running workshops in Vancouver for over 2 years, this is their first tour around BC, with 19 locations in 28 days and 21 workshops. Their goal is to creatively engage young people in hands-on projects and workshops exploring art, crafts, engineering and technology.

The day began with many kids getting involved with helping build a geodesic dome out of sticks and zip ties. That was followed by making rocket cars from pop bottles and mason jar lids that were powered by pressurized air. The kids that participated and watched had a lot of fun learning and helping. In the afternoon they worked with 3D printers and safely explored electricity. They used what they called "squishy circuits" with homemade conductive dough, LED's and batteries.

The day was definitely a blast even for the adults, and I for one hope they make this a yearly summer event. A great, completely free-to-join day of educational fun! What more could you ask for? To learn more about Maker Mobile you can visit their website at Makermobile.org.
