CHAMBER LUNCHEON - CONUMA COAL

The Chetwynd Chamber of Commerce held their second Business Luncheon of 2017 this past Thursday at the Pomeroy. This was one of their biggest turnouts with more than 65 people attending to have a fabulous lasagna lunch, provided by the Riverhouse, and listen to a presentation by the meeting's "Key Speaker," Conuma Coal's President and CEO, Mark Bartkoski.

Mark began his presentation by explaining the unconventional agreements that led up to the purchase and start up of the Brule mine, back in September of 2016. Up against 81 other companies looking at the mines and one standing bid last summer, Conuma Coal beat out the competition and ultimately saved the mines from liquidation. They requested to begin production as a Contractor of Walter Energy while they wait for permits, transfer papers and other legalities to be completed. The Courts and Government Ministries agreed to the unconventional start and Brule mine began operating on September 22nd, instantly hiring 120 employees. Just 5 months after first opening the Brule mine in Northern B.C., Conuma now employs 340 people, 92% of them being people that are local to the area. Mark says they plan to stay above 85% local employees, but also says that they hope to get more skilled workers with strong values that match those of the companies to move to the area.

Mr. Bartkoski explained that he and his other investors have other operations down in the U.S that produce up to 10 million tonnes of coal a year. The mines here in Northeast B.C have a metallurgical coal that is extremely complimentary to the their Southern mines. Most steel requires 4 types of coal combined to produce it. The Brule, Wolverine, and Willow Creek mines have great low volume, low phosphorous, and low sulphur PCI coal (Pulverized combustion injection), which is a hot commodity. The company plans to produce 5 million tonnes a year here in Northeast B.C.

Conuma Coal has two main concerns at this point - housing for employees and the railway system, which needs repair and won't be ready for transporting coal until September 1st. Mark expressed his stance on staff housing camps, and mentioned his extreme dislike for

camps that take away from their family-oriented work force.



CHAMBER LUNCHEON - CONUMA COAL

At this time there is not enough housing for their staffing needs, so something needs to be sorted out. They hope to come to an agreement with the District of Chetwynd on housing options. Mr. Bartkoski said they will build camps if it comes down to it, in order to get fully staffed. A \$10 million investment to CN Rail will be given to repair the lines which will open in September. The reopening of the rail lines will boost their profit margin and reduce trucking in and around Chetwynd.

Mark conveyed their desire for a long term partnership with the community, employees, First Nations, environment, the ministries and their investors. Conuma hopes to make a positive impact on the area and be a long lasting company. Although the companies that preceded Conuma couldn't continue to stay open through the lulls in the coal market, Mark assured everyone that with their business principles, strong values and high moral responsibility they will persevere, mainly because of their low debt coming into this. Walter Energy bought the Mines at 3.3 Billion in 2011, making for a \$1 million a day interest charge on their loan. Conuma managed to scoop up the company at a better price, letting them begin to build a low debt company. They are building their surviving status and working toward being a low cost producer, which will help down the road when coal prices dip again.

Coal markets fluctuate so frequently that Mark says they plan to get their volumes up in order to drive costs down and ultimately not have any down time due to market fluctuation. For an example of the roller coaster that is the coal market, when Conuma was looking at buying the mines last spring, coal sat at a dismal \$100 per metric tonne. In the fall of 2016, it dropped even lower to \$80 per metric tonne, but shot up once again to \$305 in December, and then dropped back down to \$140 just a few weeks ago.

The company has 235 employees from Tumbler Ridge and 100 from Chetwynd right now. They hope that in the coming months they will get 330 employees from each town, with many different career opportunities. At full development the company plans to have 650 employees, paying \$60 million in wages and \$150 million a year in transportation costs.

Mark Bartkoski finished his presentation by reiterating his hope to be a blessing to the

community, also saying that Conuma is committed to the northeast for the long term and that they are committed to their workers living and working in Chetwynd and Tumbler Ridge.


