

RED DRESS DAY REMEMBERS MURDERED AND MISSING INDIGENOUS WOMEN AND GIRLS



On Tuesday, May 4, the Tansi Friendship Centre hosted a small, non-gathering informational event at Spirit Park where people could remember and talk to Tansi employees about the issue of murdered and missing Indigenous women. Drummers and singers were also present. Indigenous peoples believe that when dancing songs are performed and women dance, it brings healing to spirits and themselves. The colour red is used because it is believed to be the only colour sprits can see, and by wearing red the missing spirits of the women can be called back to be laid to rest.

In Canada, Indigenous women account for 4% of the female population. Alarmingly, though, Indigenous women account for 16% of female homicide cases. RCMP reported in 2014 that the number of murdered and missing Indigenous women was roughly at 1200, with 1017 believed to have been killed, and the remaining 164 missing. Justin Trudeau's government promised to look into the disproportionate murders against Indigenous women and girls, but whether he has followed through on that promise is strongly debated.

Here are a few ways you can learn about the cause:

- Do an internet search for Project E-Pana. This is the name of the RCMP task force and includes the stories of dozens of women that have been murdered/are missing - Read Green River Killer - Watch Highway of Tears documentary on Prime Video - Listen to the podcast The Stolen: The Search for Connie Walker - Follow/share #MMIWG - Stop into Tansi Friendship Centre and talk to the employees there - Visit nativewomenswilderness.org

"Just ask somebody about it. Word of mouth, just talk to people. Say, 'I heard about this thing, do you know anything about it?' And then from there, hopefully you can share information," said Tansi employee Iris DeMontigny, when asked what a person who isn't particularly tech-savvy could do.

No More Stolen Sisters sweaters can be bought at Tansi, but it's worth noting that they are in high demand and have sold out several times. The National Inquiry into Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women and Girls issued their final report on June 3rd, 2019. You can head to their website, www.mmiwg-ffada.ca, to learn more. 


