Historic Inauguration in Chetwynd for New Mayor

The District of Chetwynd held their Inaugural Council Meeting this past Monday in the District Chambers. The meeting began by adopting the last meeting's agenda and then Merlin Nichols made his last remarks as Chetwynd's Mayor where he said "I've had a wonderful 7 years as Mayor of Chetwynd and, quite frankly, I'm going to miss it!" Chetwynd said goodbye to Councillor Alec Brownlee and Merlin Nichols.



The two new council members, Janet Wark and Jocelyn Disher joined Chetwynd's new Mayor, Allen Courtoreille to take their seats along with their new shiny name plaques placed above their spot. Mr. Courtoreille is the first Indigenous person to be elected as the Mayor in a small town in Canada.

Mayor Courtoreille made his declaration and Oath of Office where he mentioned he would wait until the end of the meeting for his inaugural speech. Jocelyn and Janet, along with Chetwynd's incumbent councillors also said their Declaration and Oath of Office.

Chetwynd's New Mayor, Allen Courtoreille made his inaugural speech where he thanked the community for electing him. He went on to say that he sits in a position where he will be learning and assured the room that he was not afraid to ask for help if he was unsure of something. He gave the audience a bit of a background on him and mentioned how he wouldn't have this opportunity if it weren't for his wife, his daughter Stephanie, son Ben and late son Lyonel who always believed in him. Congratulations to the Councillors who were elected for another term and

congratulations to the new Mayor and Councillors joining the team!

Fortis BC encouraging customer to continue conserving natural gas

Fortis BC is still asking customers to preserve their natural gas usage following the October 9th pipeline rupture near Prince George.

On October 31st, Enbridge reported that repairs to the 36 inch pipeline that experienced the rupture had been completed. The pipeline is expected to operate at about 80 percent of its capacity by the middle of this month. Additionally, an adjacent 30 inch pipeline was also depressurized and has been operating at 80 percent capacity since October 11th.

Fortis BC warns that until both pipelines are back at full operating pressure, their supply of natural gas will not be enough to support their customer's typical natural gas consumption. They are advising clients to turn down the thermostat and limit their hot water usage.

- Remind our kids to use caution when getting on and off the bus.
- Take down the plate number of offenders. The fine for passing a school bus with its red lights flashing is over \$300 and three demerit points.





One Hundred Years of Remembrance

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the signing of the armistice that brought the First World War and its four years of armed conflict to an end. On November 11, 1918, representatives of France, Great Britain and Germany met in a railway carriage in France to sign the historic document, paving the way for the peace negotiations that would culminate in the Treaty of Versailles, a document drafted five months later.

The anniversary of the Armistice was observed the next year in Great Britain and this tradition quickly spread to the other Allied Nations. The holiday was originally known as Armistice Day, but member states of the Commonwealth of Nations like Canada eventually adopted the name Remembrance Day.

We commemorate on this date not only citizens who fought in the First World War but also those who fought in the Second World War and every other war and peace-keeping mission since.

Although the Allies won the conflict, Armistice Day wasn' a day of unabashed celebration. Given the unspeakable horrors and death tolls in World War I, and likewise in World War II, November 11 became a day of solemn commemoration. Hence the two minutes of silence we observe on this date, a tradition that goes back to the very first Armistice Day commemoration, in 1919.
