COUNTERFEIT MONEY IN CHETWYND

CHETWYND, B.C. – Chetwynd RCMP have been receiving multiple reports of counterfeit Canadian money being passed around in the community.

Friday, January 24, RCMP say different businesses in Chetwynd had received counterfeit currency.

The RCMP are actively investigating these reports and want the public to be alert when accepting currency.

Some tips to help to identify counterfeit currency include:

- * Feel the note. Canadian currency has raised ink at different points on each note. If you run your fingernail over the shoulders of the portrait on the bill you should feel that ink.
- * Look at the note. Genuine bills have a finish that doesn't scrape off and colours that don't run when they get wet. The holographic strip should be embedded in the note, not a sticker that can peel off.
- * Flip the note: The window on each note should have the same colours and details on both sides. It should also have a metallic portrait that



mirrors the large face on the bill and changes colour when it's tilted. The windows also have small numbers that match the value of the note.

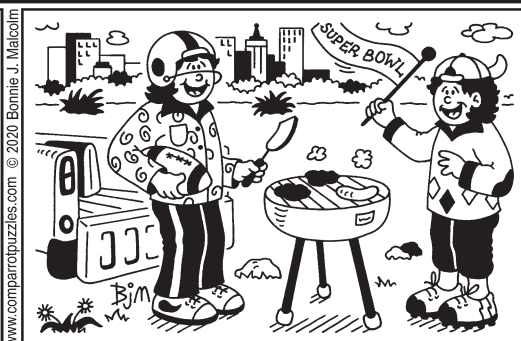
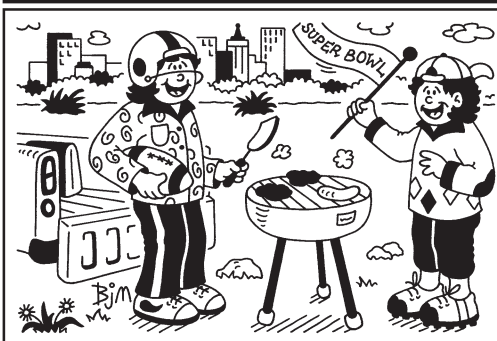

The RCMP turns 100!

Marking a century of law enforcement



11 FUN FACTS about the RCMP

February 1, 2020 marks the 100th anniversary of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. To celebrate the occasion, here are 11 interesting facts about the country's national police force.

1. The national police force in Canada was once known as the North-West Mounted Police (NWMP). The organization was founded by Prime Minister Sir John A. Macdonald after the Dominion purchased the Northwest Territories from the Hudson Bay Company in 1870.
2. On February 1, 1920, the NWMP was merged with the Dominion Police (a federal force established in 1868 to guard government buildings) in order to form the organization we know today as the RCMP.
3. The RCMP's duties include provincial policing all across Canada, except in Quebec and Ontario.
4. Women started serving in the RCMP in 1974, although the Force had hired Katherine Ryan — a.k.a. Klondike Kate — as a special constable 74 years earlier.
5. Brenda Lucki, the first permanent female commissioner of the RCMP, was appointed by Prime Minister Justin Trudeau in 2018 in Regina.
6. The eighth commissioner of the Force, Zachary Taylor Wood, was the great grandson of Zachary Taylor, the 12th president of the United States.
7. While the RCMP is well-known for its highly recognizable dress uniform, commonly referred to as the "Red Serge," their officers typically wear uniforms that resemble those of regular police forces.
8. In 2000, the RCMP debunked a surprisingly popular myth that alleged that Al Capone had used the tunnels under Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan for his bootlegging operations. According to the RCMP, there's no evidence that this ever occurred.
9. During the South African War of 1899-1902, the North-West Mounted Police helped form the Canadian Mounted Rifles by supplying more men trained in horseback riding than the regular army could.
10. Mounties were very popular in Hollywood, with several movies featuring the iconic Red Serge produced in the 1920s, 30s and 40s.
11. While it maintains a more formal and perhaps less glamorous image, the RCMP is a little like Canada's very own Federal Bureau of Investigation, enforcing federal law across the country.

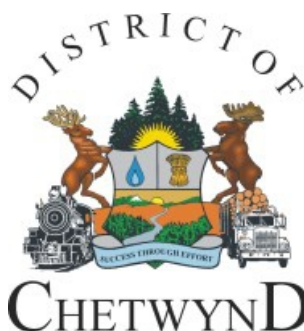

Winter Parking on District Roads Information Everyone Should Know



Winter is upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal may be removed. A full list of the District of Chetwynd Bylaws can be found on our website at www.gochetwynd.com under the heading Municipal Office/Bylaws and follow the link. For further information regarding this or other Bylaw related questions please call Bylaw Enforcement at 250-401-4119

The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13:
Obstruction of Motor Vehicles
No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

As per the District of Chetwynd's Snow Clearing Policy, snow plowing will commence after 50mm of snow accumulation, roads will be plowed on a priority basis and residential streets will be plowed within 48 hours following the subsidence of the snowfall. If vehicles are parked on residential streets following a snow fall, the road will not be cleared until all vehicles have been removed and it has been deemed safe by the District.

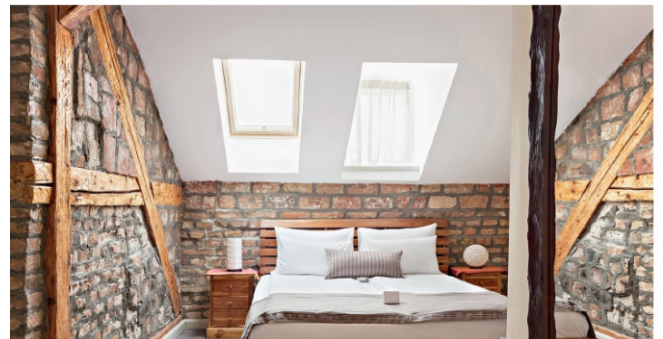
