## NH OUTBREAK UPDATE - DAWSON CREEK AND DISTRICT HOSPITAL

#### CHANGES TO ALLOW EMAILED DOCUMENTS BETWEEN LANDLORDS AND TENANTS

The Province is amending regulations to allow email as a method of service between landlords and tenants, making it easier for people to participate in the dispute resolution process. The change will take effect March 1, 2021, fulfilling a recommendation by the Rental Housing Task Force. The task force heard from renters and rental housing providers that there is a desire to use modern forms of communication, such as email, as an acceptable form of notification.

With this change, landlords and tenants may serve documents via email if one provides their email address to the other for this purpose. Previously, they were required to exchange physical documents by personal service, by regular or registered mail, leaving a copy with an adult person, leaving a copy in a mailbox, posting to a door or by fax. While electronic service methods, such as email, have not been permitted, arbitrators have accepted them in situations where other methods were not possible. As a result, they have been accepting service by email with supporting evidence without issue for several years.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, when personal service was not available to landlords and tenants, the director of the Residential Tenancy Branch issued an order allowing them to serve documents by email. With this regulatory change, email service will be available to landlords and tenants permanently. Government is also extending an order allowing strata corporations in B.C. to hold meetings electronically, including their annual and special general meetings, during the current provincial state of emergency. This temporary change under the Emergency Program Act applies to all strata corporations, regardless of whether they have a bylaw allowing electronic meetings. Strata councils already have the flexibility to hold monthly strata council meetings electronically. The order helps strata corporations hold annual or special general meetings in accordance with the provincial health officer's order against gatherings of more than 50 people.

#### **Nurturing**

To the busy young mother, her garden is a grocery store, a lesson book and a sanctuary. While picking peas, cutting beet greens and digging mounds of new potatoes, she collects a bouquet of calendula to grace the supper table. Like her dill, the flowers are volunteers from the previous year. Garden memories are perennial, too; she picked these same flowers from her mother's garden when she was a girl, and learned nurturing lessons at her mother's soiled knees.

A child grows a better heart by tending his or her own portion of the family garden; child faithfulness to duty, carefulness to detail, reaping what he sows, and how the soul is quieted by reading from the Book of Nature. "Mysteries grow clear, and that which has been hard to grasp becomes evident" (Christ's Object Lessons, p 21).

The nurturing curve is not limited to children and mothers. Sometimes, when she can do nothing else, an elderly woman still receives great joy from caring for a sunny window filled with her favourite plants—one of which she may have nurtured for half a century. A visitor's conversation naturally turns to the bright orange hibiscus blossom that has miraculously appeared since last week's visit.

"How do you do that?" asks the visitor. "My hibiscus hasn't bloomed for years!"

The elderly woman smiles and points upward. She has learned more about nurturing in the quietness of her soul than what she has learned from books. She had to have guidance in when to be gentle, when to feed, when to cut. By picturing how much more lush they will be in the spring, she severely cuts back her geraniums, even while they're still blooming. But she takes great pains not to harm a single root hair of the variegated ivy she rescued from her daughter's wedding bouquet to save it for a loving anniversary gift.

No home weather station would be complete without a rain gauge. Your kids can measure everything from the amount of rain that's fallen to how much snow has accumulated. You can buy a rain gauge or it's easy enough to make your own. Your most basic rain gauge is to simply put a jar outside, let it collect rain or snow and then stick a ruler inside to see how high the precipitation reaches.

#### **Barometer**

A barometer measures air pressure. Monitoring the changes in air pressure is one way to make predictions about the forecast. The most common barometers are Mercury Barometers or Aneroid Barometers.

#### Hygrometer

A hygrometer measures the relative humidity in the air. It's an important tool in helping forecasters predict the weather. You can buy a hygrometer for about \$5.

#### **Weather Vane**

Record the wind's direction with a weather vane. The weather vane swivels when the wind blows to show you the direction the breeze is coming from so your kids can record it. Kids can also learn if the wind is blowing north, south, east or west with a weather vane in their home weather station.

#### **Anemometer**

While the weather vane measures the direction the wind is blowing, an anemometer measures the wind's speed. Make your own anemometer with items you can find at a hardware store. Use your new anemometer with the weather vane to record wind direction and speed.

#### Windsock

A windsock is a more simple way to identify wind direction and speed as opposed to solely using a weather vane and anemometer. It's also fun for kids to watch the sock fly in the wind. Make your own windsock out of a shirt sleeve or pant leg. Your windsock can be flying in about an hour.

#### **Compass**

Even if your weather vane has the N, S, W and E points of direction, kids love holding a compass in their hands. A compass can help kids identify wind direction, which way the clouds are rolling in and can also teach kids how to navigate.

#### **Weather Journal**

A kids' weather journal can have basic information within its pages or be as detailed as you want. Younger children can draw a picture of a sunshine and the letter to mark the wind's direction. Older children can record the date, today's weather, wind speed, direction, humidity levels and make weather predictions based on their findings.

## Winter Parking on District Roads Information Everyone Should Know



When removing snow from your property it is required that the snow pile <u>must</u> remain on your property and not be pushed onto or across the roads and onto district property or other private property.

CHETWYND The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any

vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal may be removed.

The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13:

Obstruction of Motor Vehicles No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

The District of Chetwynd's Snow Clearing Policy, snow plowing will commence after 50mm of snow accumulation, roads will be plowed on a priority basis and residential streets will be plowed within 48 hours following the subsidence of the snowfall. If vehicles are parked on residential streets following a snow fall, the road will not be cleared until all vehicles have been removed and it has been deemed safe by the District.
