Cst. Sue Harvey of the Chetwynd RCMP brought a slideshow and a few words to the council meeting Tuesday, Sept 6th, about the program they launched in Chetwynd about a year ago called "Code Blue." It is essentially an after school fitness program lead by the RCMP that tries to engage our youth in healthy lifestyles.

This summer, the 12 kids that took part in the program made a trip down to Vancouver and surrounding areas to meet with other kids in the program. They did drills together and took a 2km run along the sea wall to the Peace Arch, where they participated in several other games all, while practicing the partnership and communication skills they had acquired. Although this is not at all a recruitment program for the RCMP, it is definitely providing some insight into the training involved.

Code Blue started in the Fraser Valley in 2013 and Cst. Harvey made her best effort to bring it to Chetwynd when she was transferred here two years ago. She was eventually able to adapt the program to our community, even without all the resources of a big city. With the help of a strong support system here in town and two other great facilitators from the Chetwynd RCMP, it has become a great program. The kids

that took part in the program last year are all planning to return and bring friends for this year. The program will be starting at Chetwynd Senior Secondary in the upcoming weeks, so keep a look out for sign-ups.



COUNCIL MEETING SEPTEMBER 6, 2016

The meeting began with a presentation from Cst. Susan Harvey about the program "Code Blue" and the trip she took with the group.

The Tansi Friendship Centre has applied for funding to renovate their building.

Destination Development Planning for Northeast BC will be holding a kick-off information session for tourism stakeholders on September 16th, the beginning steps to bring more tourism to Chetwynd.

There has been a request to subdivide and re-designate property from residential to industrial. The property is located at the corner of Highway 29 South and Wieland Rd.

Jay Morrison and Jason Vissers of Spectra Energy made a presentation regarding the projects taking place in and around the area. They began by expressing their commitment to safety as a core value, every employee, every job, everyday.

80% of the natural gas produced in the province touches their system. They employ 880 people, which is a lot in our region, and they also commit \$1.2 million annually to support charitable organizations. They mentioned the importance of local area planning (meaning planning for upcoming subdivisions in years to come), and how planning can reduce the risk of damage in the likely case that population density will increase.

Spectra Energy's upcoming project's total investments will be \$1.2 billion dollars after all tentative projects are complete.

- High Pine expansion has been approved and will begin construction soon.
- The Jackfish Lake expansion has already begun transporting in supplies, and will be using a lay down yard by the airport. Facility work commenced on August 15th and upstream and downstream work began on August 18th.
- •No decisions have been made on the Enhanced Pipeline Reliability program.
- •The Wyndwood project has not yet been approved by the NEB (National Energy Board).

They also wanted to let people know that they are still dealing with the aftermath of June's flood at the Pine River Gas plant and are still only running at 20% flow. However, they are expected to be at pre-flood production by December 2016.

The Chamber of Commerce will receive their requested funds of \$1600 towards hosting the Chamber Business Excellence Awards ceremony on October 22nd, 2016.

The Finance Department at the District provided a list of information regarding the District of Chetwynd's purchasing policies and practices.

The Council received more funding to help with additional costs that have come up since June's flood. The amount is 1.5 million (1.2 million from the provincial government and \$300,000 from the District's Sustainability Reserve Fund).

Alec Brownlee was appointed as Alternate Director to the Peace River Regional District, on behalf of the District of Chetwynd.

In community improvements, the Sanidump Fee Structure at the Museum is shared between the Shriners, the Museum and the District of Chetwynd. It has been recommended they restructure the Sanidump donation box with the District's portion, and then have all future proceeds go toward the Museum to help expand services and hopefully create exposure.
