





Construction of Improvements to the Sewage Treatment Plant

This Notice is to advise Electors in District of Chetwynd boundaries of the intention to adopt "District of Chetwynd Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 1020, 2015." The purpose of the Bylaw is to borrow an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 to finance the cost to construct improvements to the Sewage Treatment Plant on District-owned land that will be repaid over a period not to exceed 20 years. It is estimated that the borrowing will result in a tax increase of \$4.31 per month, or \$54.71 annually, for the average residential property.

A copy of Bylaw No. 1020, 2015 and a summary of the proposal are available from the District Office during each business day of the week between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

The District of Chetwynd proposes to borrow the money to construct improvements at the Sewage Treatment Plant unless, by 4:30 p.m. on June 1, 2015, at least 10% of the Electors in the whole of the District of Chetwynd sign an Elector Response Form opposing the implementation of the proposal unless the District of Chetwynd holds a vote. The number of Elector Responses required to prevent the District of Chetwynd from proceeding unless a vote is held is estimated to be 182. A report respecting the basis on which this determination was made is available upon request from the District Office.

Alternative Approval Elector Response Forms:

In accordance with Community Charter s. 86 (2)(e)(i) & (ii), Elector Response Forms are required to be submitted to the District of Chetwynd on forms that can be obtained during regular business hours from the District Office; the form may also be downloaded from the District's website at www.gochetwynd.com The only Elector Response Form that will be accepted are the ones provided by the District of Chetwynd or an accurate copy of the form.

Only Electors of the District of Chetwynd are eligible to sign the elector response forms. There are two types of electors - resident electors and non-resident property electors.

Resident Elector - a person who is a Canadian citizen, is 18 years of age or older, has resided in BC for the previous six months and has resided within District of Chetwynd boundaries for the previous 30 days prior to signing an Elector Response Form.

Non-resident property elector - a person who is a Canadian citizen, is 18 years of age or older, has resided in BC for the previous six months and has owned property within District of Chetwynd boundaries for the previous 30 days prior to signing an Elector Response Form. Note that only one non-resident property elector may sign an elector response form per property, regardless of how many people own the property.



Non-resident property electors must provide their full name, residential address and the address of the property in relation to which they are entitled to register as a non-resident property elector. 

The RCMP in Dawson Creek released this photo showing the goods that were stolen during the crime spree that ended on April 1.

Michael Ginter, 29, and Joseph Semple, 33, have been charged with more than 50 counts of possession of stolen property in connection with a string of thefts in the Peace Region. They were found passed out behind the wheel of two separate stolen vehicles in different locations in Dawson Creek

Police have estimated that over \$200,000 in

goods were recovered. It has taken days for the local detachment to process all of the stolen items.

Crown prosecutors are recommending 48 charges against the two men who are both from Grande Prairie.
