## KELSEY'S CHRONICLE



January sees the biggest influx of people getting fit, but by now many have fallen off the wagon of their new year's resolution to shed some extra pounds and get healthy? It's time to chase after that wagon and climb back on. With all the marathons, hikes, obstacle races and other fitness adventures coming up throughout the spring and summer, who wouldn't want to set a goal to compete in one of these fitness related events around the Peace Region?

Getting fit is about finding a form of exercise that you don't despise. You don't have to love it, either, but it's easier to stay motivated when you at least somewhat enjoy the activity. The best way to find out what suits your style is to try a few things out - borrow a bike and try some cycling or roller blade around your neighbourhood. Even dancing in your living room burns calories, is a great form of cardio and improves flexibility.

There are many fitness trends this spring to get excited about. You could find someone offering outdoor bootcamp sessions, join a running group or even an "accountability group." These usually help people to stay on track with eating healthy or keeping active (because your friends help to motivate with pictures of their healthy meals or those good old "sweaty selfies" LOL ). Another big trend this year is fitness trackers. Whether it's a Fitbit or a knock off, some like keeping track of their kms walked and their heart rate. It can even encourage you to get up and move.

There is one trap that so many people fall into, diet shakes and supplements. I cannot stress enough how these are solely a money grab... this may push a few buttons of faithful shake and supplement users but if you aren't losing weight in a healthy way, you won't keep it off. Sure, you could lose 20 pounds in your first month, but as soon as you stop drinking the \$200 shake you will immediately see the pounds coming back. You want some chips? Limit your intake to a cereal bowl full, and not everyday.

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## OPENING OF SEPTAGE RECEIVING FACILITY

The District of Chetwynd announced the opening of the new Septage Receiving Facility this past Tuesday. The facility is located across from the Public Works Yard on Airport Rd. The District partnered with the Peace River Regional District on this project and Mayor Nichols and PRRD Director Dan Rose cut the ribbon for the facility.

Before this project was completed, users were able to dispose of any sewage into the receiving station with no recourse. Several years ago this had a catastrophic impact at the District's Sewage Treatment Plant that resulted in exceeding the permitted levels of effluent discharge into the Pine River.

Paul Gordon, Director of Engineering & Public Works, went over the specifics of the new advanced facility, which is equipped with very sensitive testing equipment. This sensor will detect the presence of hydrocarbons (such as harmful oils) and monitor PH looking for caustic acidic materials. The facility also keeps track of conductivity, heavy metals found in industrial waste.

If there is an issue and the waste doesn't meet the acceptable parameters, an alarm will sound and all valves will close to stop the discharge. There is a separate chamber/holding tank that the material will be contained in. The user would then have to pump the affluent back into their vehicle. Each user will have their own ID number they must use in order to identify where waste is coming from.

Funding for this facility was included as part of the \$2,992,254 Federal/Provincial Building Canada-Small Communities Infrastructure grant to rebuild the Sewage Treatment Plant in 2016. The Peace River Regional District generously donated \$500,000 towards this project.

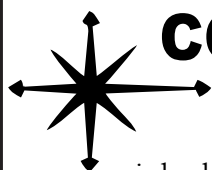

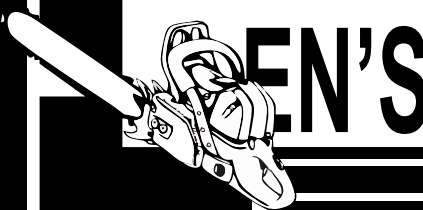

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# MEET THE MAYOR

May 12, 2017

We frequently see the resources we harvest, extract, collect, or mine in our great North East loaded on trucks or trains for far-away places; but I, for one, seldom think of what happens at the other end of the transportation corridors winding through British Columbia, beside its great rivers and cheerful rills, across pleasant farm lands, through peaceful communities, and braving its rugged mountains to the sea ports of Vancouver and Prince Rupert. Highways 97 and 16 are the major truck routes to the ports. CN Rail with its ribbons of steel (50 % metallurgical coal perhaps from our mountains) is the only train option to carry our commerce.

I am writing this column from my hotel room in Terrace, the site of the 2017 North Central Local Government Association (NCLGA) convention. Every year about this time the NCLGA convention brings together in one of our northern communities (last year hosted by Dawson Creek, Tumbler Ridge, and Chetwynd) a few hundred elected officials and senior municipal administrators for three days of learning and exposure to ideas.

This year, in addition to the regular convention fare, I had opportunity to take a long-day's tour of the Port of Prince Rupert, an altogether eye-opening experience. Our group of elected officials from across the North were treated to a tour of the harbour in a whale-watching boat to see the port activities from the perspective of the whale. We watched two tugs maneuver a loaded container ship into berth, marveled at literally mountains of coal waiting to be transferred to ships bound for the far-East (next boat scheduled to arrive on May 9), noted the massive silos for storage of wood pellets prior to loading, and saw the construction of the propane-shipping facility that in about two years will be loading out propane from the Montney play in our own back yard.

Disembarking the whale boat and reboarding the bus we were taken to observe the processes up close. The Container ship was now securely berthed and ready to shed its burden. This was, to me, the most fascinating of the entire port experience. You buy from Costco, Canadian Tire, Walmart, and several other outlets whose trinkets land on our shores in one of those containers. (I know you do because they keep bringing the stuff to our shores.) The Port is capable of loading a container train, destination Chicago and points east, every seven hours and about 1.5 train loads of containers were stacked in the loading yard and in process of being loaded. (One train is about 11,000 feet long.)

Time to Chicago from Prince Rupert is the same as time from Los Angeles. Having saved three days of sea shipping to the port makes Prince Rupert highly competitive and the port is growing in capacity daily.

Canada Customs operates a massive warehouse where selected containers are unloaded and examined with highly sensitive scanners in search of contraband. Several containers can be searched in one day. Obviously this is only a fraction of the containers arriving each day in Prince Rupert.

I also witnessed Canfor and West Fraser lumber waiting to be containerized for shipment to customers in foreign ports.

Coal and pellet trains are emptied by highly specialized equipment. Coal is separated at the port according to owner and type allowing the customer to connect with the miner for the desired product.

Pellet trains are emptied through a magnetized grill into a conveyor system that transfers the pellets to the silo. Pellet temperature is monitored to ensure that overheating in the silo does not occur.

Finally, we were taken to the site of the construction of the propane shipping facility due to be commissioned in about two years.

So much of our Peace River commerce reaches the world through the Port of Prince Rupert. Linked by highway and rail, we form a continuous family of producer and shipper each depending on the other for the prosperity of all.

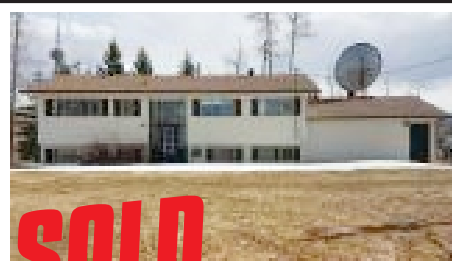
