November's regular council meeting of the District of Chetwynd took place this past Monday, November 18th at the Council Chambers. All members of Council were in attendance, as well as the Mayor.

The first, second and third readings of the Revenue Anticipation bylaw began the meeting.

They went on to committee reports where Councillor Bassendowski updated the room about the new staff at the Peace Fm office and the newest happenings around there.

Council moved along to discussion items where they decided to send a letter of support for the Chetwynd Circus Camp's grant application. They also decided that mayor and council will attend the Hockey Meet and Greet in Dawson Creek on December 10th.

Councillors were then appointed to different boards and committees for the year.

The last item on the docket was an update on the vacant property beside the new Lakeview Credit Union, where administration mentioned that it is in the final steps before construction begins on a new row of shops. More information will be known about exactly what we can expect to see in the beginning of January 2020.

Councillor Wark finished the meeting by asking about a time line for the new boulevard lights. She was told by administration that there was a delay on the poles, but everything is within weeks of being installed. Councillor Wark also went on to mention that she feels that Chetwynd's Firefighters should be recognized by Mayor and Council at future council meetings. Councillor Weisgerber went on to say that she feels it should be extended to RCMP members to help welcome them to the town, as well.

The last meeting of 2019 will take place on December 16th.





Winter Parking on District Roads Information **Everyone Should Know**



Winter is upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal may be removed. A full list of the District of Chetwynd Bylaws can be found on our website at www.gochetwynd.com under the heading Municipal Office/Bylaws and follow the link. For further information regarding this or other Bylaw related questions please call Bylaw Enforcement at 250-401-4119

The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13:

As per the District of Chetwynd's Snow Clearing Policy, snow plowing will commence after 50mm of snow accumulation, roads will be plowed on a priority basis and residential streets will be plowed within 48 hours following the subsidence of the snowfall. If vehicles are parked on residential streets following a snow fall, the road will not be cleared until all vehicles have been removed and it has been deemed safe by the District.

CN Rail Strikes for Safer **Work Conditions**

Thousands of workers with Canada's largest rail network, CN Rail are on strike. Picketing, as they are locked out until an agreement is reached.

Teamsters Canada Rail Conference (TCRC), the union representing the workers, and Canadian National Railways (CN) failed to reach an agreement on a new contract before a midnight deadline Monday, November 18th.

The union and the company have been in negotiations for seven months and have been working with federal mediators for the past five months.

"We are disappointed that the TCRC has initiated strike action," a spokesperson for CN Rail told Global News in a statement on Tuesday. Who went on to say, "We will return to the negotiating table today, with the assistance of federal mediators."

The CN service disruption involves more than 3,000 workers, including conductors, train persons and vard workers. A number of them hit the picket lines Tuesday morning, after the deadline passed, halting freight trains across the country.

I spoke with Ross, a local Chetwynd CN employee who said. "There won't be any trains arriving in Chetwynd or leaving until an agreement is reached."

The union says its members are concerned about "dangerous practices," including the requirement that workers operate trains alone, from the outside of the train, "hanging on to moving trains with one hand while operating a remotely controlled locomotive with the other. Railroaders are expected to do this in rain and in freezing temperatures, sometimes for distances of up to about 17 miles," TCRC spokesperson Christopher Monette said in a statement.

On top of dangerous conditions, workers are also concerned with fatigue. The union claims CN is "making it harder" for its members to get needed rest by increasing work hours and reducing staffing levels. Wages are not part of the dispute.

This will undoubtedly cause strain on industry in the area. With many companies already planning to slow production until CN is up and going again.

CHRISTMASSY RECIPE: CHRISTMAS PORCHETTA

- Ingredients
 1 pork belly, about 3-4kg, deboned, skin on
- 1 tbsp fennel seeds
- 1 tbsp fine salt
- 1 tsp chilli flakes
- 1 tsp black peppercorns
- 4 cloves garlic, roughly chopped
- 2 tbsp fresh rosemary leaves, roughly chopped
- extra fine salt
- chimichurri, to serve

Method

- 1. Start preparing the pork belly the day before cooking. Using a mortar and pestle, pound the fennel seeds, salt, chilli flakes, peppercorns, garlic and rosemary together to make a paste. Rub the paste on to the inside of the pork belly.
- 2. Roll pork belly lengthways and, using butcher's twine, tie the meat at 21/2 centimetre intervals to hold it together. Cover with cling film and leave in fridge at least overnight.
- 3. Remove prepared porchetta from fridge and uncover. Season with fine salt all over the skin. Leave for one or two hours to draw out moisture. Wipe with a clean, damp cloth to remove salt.
- 4. Half an hour before cooking, preheat oven to 150C. Place porchetta on a rack inside a baking tray. Put in oven to cook for 21/2 to three hours. If, after this time, the skin has not crackled, increase the heat to 200C for 15 minutes. Remove from oven and leave to sit at least until warm.
- 5. To serve, remove string and cut pork into one-centimetre slices using a serrated knife. Serve with chimichurri.
