

According to Brand, people can learn to ignore pain or better cope with it through active distraction rather than becoming dependent on pain medication.

A fever burns out a virus; to kill the fever with a pain reliever may relieve aches, but may lengthen or even increase the intensity of the illness. Carefully weigh the need for comfort; youngsters are at risk of convulsing with a high rise in temperature and should be taken to hospital. Pregnant or nursing mothers must consult the ingredient list and side-effects of every remedy, whether home-grown or pharmaceutical in nature.

And don't forget about applying the scientifically proven soothing, healing power of prayer—the original home comfort!

The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles No vehicle shall be left standing or parked: (I) in violation of this bylaw;

(ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with firefighting;

(iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement,

maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.

District of Chetwynd 2020 Year End Review

2020 was the last year budgeted for the 4-year playground replacement program; playground equipment was

replaced in the Ballfield Park, Spirit Park, Don Titus Fitness Park and the Rec Centre outdoor playground. Going forward, playground equipment will be replaced as necessary.

The indoor playground was installed at the Rec Centre in 2020. The public have been asking for this for years, so although the opening has been post-poned until Covid-19 is under control, we're very excited to provide this free amenity for children.

The washrooms in Spirit Park have been winterized and are now open 24/7. So far, all the feedback has been positive and the washrooms are used often by people enjoying the park.

In 2020 a very heavy rainfall event on Canada Day caused some damage to boulevards and Creekside property. The Province is assisting the District to repair the damage.

Dan Golob was hired as a new Fire Chief in November, 2020. Dan has a lot of experience in firefighting and he's excited to be in Chetwynd

The largest capital project constructed in Chetwynd in 2020 was a sewer replacement on 53rdPlace NW and 51st Avenue SW, for an expenditure of \$1,100,000; paving was completed on the Nicholson Road intersection and other priority areas.

Covid-19 is an ongoing concern and the District of Chetwynd has implemented safety plans for each of its departments in conjunction with WorkSafeBC templates and direction from Northern Health and Public Health Orders. The District of Chetwynd remains flexible and ready to respond to future recommendations from those agencies to keep employees and members of the public safe wherever possible.

A continued 5% discount on utilities (water/sewer/garbage) invoices until the end of June 2021.

Proposed 2% property tax increase for 2021.

The Province of BC awarded the District a grant for Covid-19 restart and the allocation for that funding was decided (part of it will cover the 5% discount on utilities, and other expenses the District experienced due to Covid-19).

Spruce Ridge Program— Chetwynd Loop Construction



Please be advised that Westcoast Energy Inc., doing business as Enbridge, will be completing construction of the Chetwynd Loop as part of the Spruce Ridge Program between December 14, 2020 and October 31, 2021.
