MP ZIMMER AND MP CALKINS CO-HOST VIRTUAL RURAL CRIME PANEL DISCUSSION

April 9, 2021 (Blackfalds) - Yesterday evening Blaine Calkins, Member of Parliament for Red Deer-Lacombe, and Bob Zimmer, Member of Parliament for Prince George-Peace River-Northern Rockies, co-hosted a virtual panel discussion with members of the community about the issues surrounding rural crime in Alberta and Northern BC.

"As Chair of the Conservative Rural Crime Caucus, I am pleased we had the opportunity to once again speak to Canadians about the issues of rural crime and update them on Conservative initiatives to combat this very serious issue," said Calkins. "The Liberal's soft-on-crime agenda has created countless victims of crime all across Canada, particularly in rural areas. Canadians deserve better, and Canada's Conservatives are working hard to target criminals who target rural Canadians."

Mr. Calkins and Mr. Zimmer welcomed a variety of panelists including representatives from the RCMP's E Division North and K Division, the president of the Alberta Provincial Rural Crime Watch Association, an Investigation and Risk Management Specialist, and a victim of rural crime.

The panelists spoke about how measures to address rural crime have been progressing, current trends, as well as how the pandemic and associated public health orders have impacted rural crime. Other topics covered were concerns surrounding habitual offenders, crime prevention, the role of civil society in addressing rural crime, and inadequacies in the justice system.

"I want to thank everyone who participated in this discussion as well as Blaine for his continued efforts on this important issue. He has always been a stalwart defender of rural Canadians," said Zimmer. "Crime has affected far too many in our community. Instead of this Liberal government focusing on the ones perpetuating the crime, they have chosen to focus resources on law-abiding firearms owners and reducing consequences for serious crime. We need a government that will tackle rural crime straight on."

Health For Your Home by Linda Franklin

Natural Remedies for Sinusitis (Part 2)

This is a continuation of last week's discussion of sinusitis, the term used to identify an infection of the nasal cavity, often causing swollen tissue and/or excessive mucous production that can be caused most often by either allergies or a germ infection.

Essential oils: Apply lavender oil to soles of feet at bedtime. Swallow 2-3 drops oil of oregano in glass of warm water twice a day. Oregano is one oil that is sometimes stronger from one source than another, in which case use one drop.

Herbal Teas for Sinusitis: Oregano-Thyme-Rosemary-Ginger: Bring a quart of water to simmering boil and remove from heat. Add 1/4-1/2 teaspoon of each herb (fresh or dry): oregano is anti-histamine and anti-septic, rosemary is anti-allergy and thyme clears mucous. Steep for 10 minutes, and then pour the contents of the pot through a sieve into a quart jar. Drink a cup or two of this tea while it's hot, and the remainder through the day. Echinacea tea is good for those who are not allergic to ragweed or daisies.

Soup: Make a tasty and simple one-dish meal that includes some cruciferous veggies (cabbage, kale, broccoli) along with potatoes (especially include the skins!) and garlic or onion. This soup is antiseptic and antihistamine. Garlic actually kills influenza viruses, so add a garlic sandwich to the daily menu or blend a clove or two into your salad dressing until you are well again.

Prolonged sinus infections that resist natural remedies should be diagnosed by a physician as there are certain diseases besides colds, flu and allergies that can mimic these diseases.

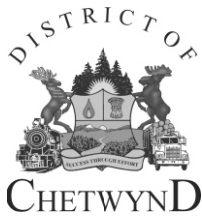

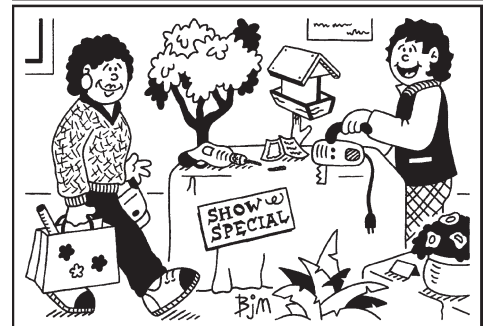

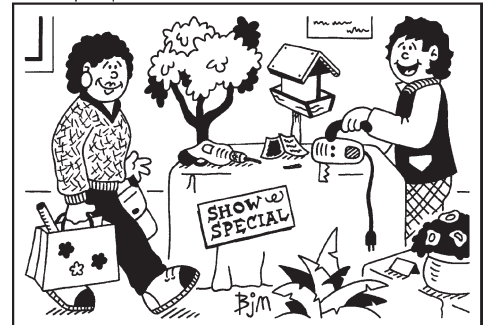
