RCMP Investigation Results in Discovery of Sarah Foord, an Arrest and Homicide Charges.

A major crime investigation that initially began on July 10th, as a missing person investigation became a homicide investigation with charges being laid. On Friday, July 10, 2020 Sarah FOORD (38) was reported by a family member as missing to the Fort St John RCMP. On July 13, 2020 the BC RCMP North District Major Crime Unit became engaged in the missing person investigation when investigators were unable to rule out foul play. The BC RCMP Major Crime Unit, Fort St

John RCMP, Surrey RCMP, Forensic Identification/Forensic Search Units, Police Dog Section and other units from across the BC and Alberta worked collectively to try and locate Sarah FOORD. On July 24th, 2020 the continuing investigation resulted in the recovery of human remains in a remote location approximately 75 km north of Fort St John. In consultation with the BC Coroner Service, and Sarah's family the remains were confirmed to be those of Sarah FOORD. The Investigative findings were provided to the BC Prosecution Service and on July 25th, 2020 the BCPS approved one count of 2nd degree murder against 35 year old John Wendell KEYLER for the murder of Sarah FOORD. KEYLER was arrested without incident in Fort St John on and will make an appearance on Tuesday, July 28th, 2020.

RCMP investigators continue to update Sarah's family on the progress of the investigation and will continue to provide them support.

"I want to acknowledge all of the police investigators, staff and analysts who worked day and night on this investigation to find Sarah and secure a charge for her death" says Insp. Lorne Wood, North District Major Crime. "Also on behalf of the investigative team I want to thank Sarah's family, members of the public and local businesses who came forward with information to assist with the investigation into the disappearance of Sarah. Our priority now is to prepare for court process".



Massive recall on Ethanol Based Sanitizer

Health Canada says certain hand sanitizers made with ethanol or denaturants are not acceptable ingredients for use in hand sanitizers - and has recalled a long list of products.

Total Contract of the Contract

Health Canada is advising Canadians that certain hand sanitizers are being

recalled from the market because they contain ethanol or denaturants that are not acceptable for use in hand sanitizers in Canada. Denaturants are added to ethanol to make it unfit for human consumption and, therefore, to avoid the unintentional ingestion of hand sanitizers (particularly by children).

Since these unacceptable types of ethanol and denaturants have not been approved for use in hand sanitizers in Canada, the Department has not reviewed them for safety or efficacy. Multiple types of unacceptable ethanol and denaturants have been found in hand sanitizer products," says Health Canada.

Possible adverse reactions to the ingredients in these products may include dermatitis, such as skin irritation and cracking; eye irritation; upper respiratory system irritation; and headaches. Health Canada will update this list if it becomes aware of other affected products, so that Canadians can easily identify ones they may have purchased and take appropriate action. Canadians are encouraged to consult the list regularly for updates.

Health Canada also maintains a list of hand sanitizers that contain technical-grade ethanol and are being recalled from the market because they are not compliant with federal regulations and may pose a risk to health.

What you should do:

Stop using the products listed below or on the list of hand sanitizers that contain technical-grade ethanol and may pose a risk to health. Please follow municipal or regional guidelines on how to dispose of chemicals and other hazardous waste. You may also return the product to your local pharmacy for proper disposal.
