

With camping season in full swing and an awful tragic death of a young mom in the province, it's always good to remind ourselves of the dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning - the silent killer. Carbon monoxide not only has no odour, it has no taste and no colour. These gasses are made whenever you burn fuel such as oil, coal, wood, gas, propane and natural gas.

Many camp stoves are run from burning fuel which can be a big problem if there is no ventilation. While people are at a greater risk during the winter months, things like generators and camp stoves can be a big risk of carbon monoxide poisoning while camping also.

If you own a camper or trailer, make sure you are equipped with a carbon monoxide monitor and if you have one make sure it is functioning properly. Note that smoke alarms are NOT the same as CO monitors.

Carbon monoxide poisoning can cause health problems even before you notice it's present. It actually reduces your body's ability to carry oxygen to

At low levels effects are similar to flu like symptoms - fatigue, headache, shortness of breath, impaired motor functions like muscle weakness and partial to total loss of body function.

At high levels - dizziness, chest pain, poor vision, difficulty breathing. And at extreme levels - convulsions, coma and death.

On top of CO monitors, you should also regularly examine propane and natural gas powered appliances for leaks, cracks, blocked vents, poor connections and corroded or broken connecting or venting pipes.

Here are a list of things that should not be used in closed, non ventilated areas - trimmers, generators, lawnmowers, snowblowers, barbecues (both propane and charcoal), and kerosene or oil space heaters (unless designed

With these tips you can better educate those around you to ensure no one else falls victim to this silent killer.

When you buy a condo or single family home that's part of a planned development, vou're often required to join a homeowners' association (HOA). An HOA is an organiza tion that's in charge of the regulation and upkeep of private properties in a residential community. Here are three things you need to know before joining one.

1. Fees. HOA fees range anywhere from \$100 and up per month. It's important to consider these fees when deciding whe ther you can afford to buy a home.

- 2. Rules. Some HOAs have strict rules dic tating how you maintain your property. Find out what types of changes you're allowed to make to the appearance of your home and yard and whether you're allowed to have pets or rent out your property.
- 3. Services. You also need to know exactly what you're paying for in terms of ame nities. Depending on the community, the HOA may perform only basic maintenance tasks or provide biggerticket services

such as free access to a pool or community clubhouse.
