ASSISTANCE IN FINDING WANTED WOMAN

The Fort St. John RCMP are looking for the public's help to find Alexis Dawn Chin.

Chin is wanted on numerous outstanding warrants including breach of recognizance. So far the RCMP have not been able to locate Chin who is of no fixed address.

Chin is described as a caucasian female, 33 years-old, about 5'9" with brown hair and green eyes.

This isn't the first time the RCMP have been looking for Alexis Chin. In 2012, the RCMP were looking for Chin relation to numerous charges including break, enter and theft, two counts of possession of property obtained by crime, theft over \$5,000 and failing to comply with the conditions of her recognizance.

In July of 2015, Chin was arrested and faced charges of Possession of Cocaine for the Purpose of Trafficking, Possession of Fentanyl for the Purpose of Trafficking, Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm as well as Careless Storage of a Firearm.

It's been one month since a 15-year-old disappeared between Taylor and Dawson Creek.

On March 22, the RCMP said Denny Poole was last seen on March 12 around 7:30 p.m. near the south side of the Kiskatinaw River Bridge, between Dawson Creek and Taylor.

RCMP have said that Denny, along with a friend, were attempting to walk from Dawson Creek to Fort St. John on March 12. But the teenager never got to his intended destination, nor was he seen

The boy is described as being about five foot seven inches tall and weighing between 120 and 130 pounds. He has short black hair and brown eyes. Denny was last seen wearing a grey DGK sweater, black jeans, Osirus running shoes, and he had a black

backpack.

MEET THE MAYOR **April 15, 2016**

I had promised myself not to write another column any time soon on forestry. But I'm at another Council of Forest Industries (COFI) conference and forestry is the backbone of our local economy. Surrounded by producers, regulators, law makers, foresters, haulers of chips, builders of machines, and virtually every other business or profession related ever so casually to forestry, what can I do? I am compelled to write. My fingers twitch if I don't turn them loose on the keyboard.

Listening to economists (not to be confused with paying them any attention) is always one of my favorite pastimes. I don't suppose they have any measurable influence on how the economy performs, economic performance probably being primarily a function of you and me and the things we buy or forget to buy, but it is good to walk away with three or four points of view from a pair of presenters. By their own admission, the profession of economist was created to make astrologers look good and within their professional ranks they boast of three categories: those who can count and those who cannot count.

That said, the fact that our bread and butter grows on trees should give us pause to reflect on the viewpoints of those who make it their business to follow and study the trends in the forest industry from governance and regulation to planning and harvesting through production, sales, distribution, and utilization of the products of the forest. (No, I haven't forgotten silviculture.)

Economic trends are shifting from month to month, maybe from day to day, so following them is an art as well as a science and a statistical wonder. For instance, we learned that we are entering a period of strengthening markets which won't necessarily apply in 2016 during which we can expect disappointing growth.

Our local economic prosperity largely depends on the behaviour of the Americans where numbers of persons per household are decreasing (resulting in the need for more housing) while simultaneously the 25-35s are starting to wake up and think they need their own roofs. All this will put additional pressure on the industry. However, it seems that the industry is gearing up to meet the challenge with increased capacity.

There are also increasing challenges from other directions. Newsprint production has decreased by 55%. (Notice the vanishing newspapers.) The sale of chips to the pulp mills has been a major contributor to the prosperity of the local sawmills. Those of us who can remember the mid 70s may recall the mountains of chips at the local mills - chips that were sold to pulp mills. That never ceased, but a major reduction in demand for pulp will flow back and back to affect the viability of the lumber producer.

Government and industry have their work cut out to find ways to keep the forestry business profitable in the face of new and stimulating challenges. No doubt these challenges will be overcome; we may have to pay the cost.

On Wednesday, April 6th, the music world lost a legend when Merle Haggard died on the occasion of his 79th birthday. His musical legacy will live on forever thanks to the countless classics he penned, including 38 #1 hits, over the course of his life. He began his career in a highly unusual manner, serving time in San Quentin Penitentiary for a drunken robbery he committed, where he witnessed one of fellow legend Johnny Cash's famous prison performances. The show triggered a realization for Haggard, who knew he didn't want to spend his life wasting away in a grey prison cell, and who upon release immediately engrossed himself in the world of country music.

Luckily for Merle, he was gifted with one of the most beautiful and expressive voices the music world would ever be blessed with, as well as the talent for crafting songs that would touch the hearts of millions. While many

country stars would sing outlaw anthems about committing crimes and being on the run from the law, Haggard was one of the few with real experiences, and the authenticity that shone through his voice was clear to all who heard it.

He was a complicated man, pigeonholed by many for his famous anti-hippie anthem "Okie From Muskogee," which was either a serious indictment of the 1960s counterculture or a satirical jab at the staunch, reserved ways of folks in Muskogee, depending on which interview with Haggard you read. His record company forced him to follow "Okie" with "The Fightin' Side Of Me," another song reprimanding the counterculture for not supporting American values, but this went against Haggard's wishes, as he had hoped to soften his image by making "Irma Jackson" the follow-up single. The song is about a white man's romance with a black woman, and the record company feared a backlash from country fans in the Deep South, prompting the release of the far more conservative "Fightin'."

Merle Haggard went from performing for Richard Nixon at the White House in 1973 to calling him one of the worst presidents America ever had, from railing against hippies to openly campaigning for the legalization of marijuana, but throughout his career one constant was his love and compassion for those who struggle. If you struggled to pay your bills or struggled being branded by society for something you'd done in the past, Merle had your back. While he had a few run-ins with pneumonia in his later years, he kept writing, recording and touring right up until the end, releasing his final album "Django & Jimmie" last year, a collaboration with his long-time friend and fellow icon Willie Nelson.

Country music these days has more in common with the hair metal of the 1980s, preferring to indulge in partying and good time anthems rather than any meaningful substance, and it certainly sounds nothing like the country music that came before it and will surely outlast it. The country music made by legends like Merle, Willie, Johnny Cash, Buck Owens, Dolly Parton and Hank Williams (to name only a few) has a timeless quality, capable of touching people (like myself) who were born long after the "Golden Age" of country had come to an end. We will always have the songs, and if you're looking for a few Haggard classics to pay tribute to the man, I recommend "Sing Me Back Home," "Mama Tried," "Workin' Man Blues," "Daddy Frank (The Guitar Man)," "I Think I'll Just Stay Here And Drink," "Always Wanting You," "Pancho And Lefty (with Willie Nelson)," and my personal favourite, the live version of "Rainbow Stew."




