New Peace region wind project commissioned south of Chetwynd

The Zonnebeke Energy Project is located 16 kilometres south of Chetwynd and 9 kilometres west of Lone Prairie. The West Moberly First Nation and Natural Forces celebrated Earth Day with their newly-commissioned Zonnebeke wind project.

The project, south of Chetwynd, consists of four turbines with a capacity of 15MW, enough energy to power 5,800 homes "The Zonnebeke project exemplifies the truly clean renewable energy the world needs to move forward," said West Moberly Chief Roland Willson in a release. "It is through business partnerships and relationships like this that First Nations can and will develop true sustainable opportunities which in-turn enable the Nations to grow and prosper."

The project was developed as a partnership between West Moberly First Nations and Natural Forces, and was developed in tandem with a separate, nearby project, Sukunka Energy Project, which is a partnership between Saulteau First Nations and Natural Forces.

"Working with Chief Willson and his colleagues has been a fantastic experience," said John Brereton, President at Natural Forces. "We are very grateful to have been part of this project that will generate clean, emission-free electricity in British Columbia and deliver economic prosperity to our partners at West Moberly First Nations."

West Moberly and Natural Forces signed an Electricity Purchase Agreement with BC Hydro in July 2019 for the sale of energy generated from the project.

"We're pleased the Zonnebeke Energy Project will add to BC Hydro's clean, renewable electricity supply and help to power thousands of homes in B.C.," said BC Hydro President and CEO Chris O'Riley. "We are committed to building and maintaining meaningful relationships with Indigenous groups, including the West Moberly First Nations, and this project is an example of that."



Staying Positive



Make Your Own Bubble Blowing Mixture!

Bubbles captivate people of all ages. Perhaps it's their rainbow reflective surface, the way they float on a breeze, or the satisfaction that comes from popping them. Whatever your reason is, it's easy to find the joy in them. Bubbles can keep small children enthralled for hours, and older kids can find satisfaction in making this recipe for the best bubble solution ever.

Making bubble solution is also a great STEM activity for young budding scientists. You can introduce concepts about surface tension (What shape is a bubble? Can a bubble be a cube or a pyramid?), matter (Are bubbles solids, liquids, or gas? Answer: They are actually a thin layer of liquids filled with the gas O2), and wind direction (Can you tell which way the wind is blowing from how the bubbles float?) to kids in an engaging hands-on way.

Use this recipe to keep yourself, your family, and friends enjoying bubbles all year long. If young children are using the bubble solution, make sure they keep it away from their eyes, as soap can irritate them. **Equipment / Tools**

Materials

1 tablespoon dish soap 1 tablespoon glycerine 1 jar **Bubble wands** 1 cup water

1. Measure and Pour the Water Into the Jar

Using your measuring cup, measure out 1 cup of water. Pour the water into the jar.

2. Measure and Add Dish Soap to the Jar

Add 1 tablespoon of dish soap to the water in the jar. Any brand of dish soap will work here. Dish soap helps create the bubbles, but dish soap alone won't work well for your bubble blowing mixture. Proceed to the next step to learn about glycerine and how it ties the entire mixture together, and the science behind bubbles forming and popping.

3. Measure and Add Glycerine to the Jar

Measure out 1 tablespoon of glycerine and add to the water and dish soap mixture in the jar. Glycerine is a sugary compound that mixes with the dish soap to form a thicker bubble. Bubbles "Pop!" when the water that's trapped within the soap bubble evaporates. A thicker bubble will keep the water from evaporating longer, and the bubble from popping so soon!

4. Stir the Bubble Mixture Together

Stir the bubble solution mixture together using a wooden popsicle stick, a spoon, or anything you have handy that works as a stirrer! Once the mixture is combined, test it out! If you find that the bubbles aren't forming well, you may need to add a little more dish soap or glycerine.

While this craft comes together in minutes, kids will enjoy hours of fun forming bubbles outside on a beautiful day! Make a small collection of these jars to keep with your outdoor toys and your kiddos will be entertained all season long.
