Crypto Scams Targeting B.C. Residents

The B.C. RCMP, British Columbia Securities Commission (BCSC), Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre (CAFC) and municipal police are warning the public about an emerging trend of fraudsters using social media and online dating sites to lure B.C. residents into crypto-asset scams.

In the first eight months of 2021, British Columbians reported losses of \$3.5 million from crypto investment scams – more than triple the amount lost last year, which was just over \$1 million, according to CAFC data. On average, only five per cent of fraud victims report such incidents to authorities.

Fraudsters are adapting their techniques to the latest trends and technologies, using a variety of tactics to defraud victims:

- People are approached via dating apps or other social media sites. After developing an online relationship, the fraudster brings up an investment opportunity and convinces the person to make an initial payment. The fraudster is often able to convince victims to continue investing, which can lead to substantial losses.
- The fraudsters identify a person's friend, and then take control of the friend's social media accounts. The suspect, posing as the friend, easily convinces the person to take advantage of the supposed investment opportunity.
- Fraudsters research their potential victims online, including reviewing their social media posts, in order to come up with tailored strategy for each victim to maximize their chances of success.
- The fraudster, while calling with a pitch for crypto-asset investment, convinces a person to provide remote access to his or her computer. The suspect shows the person a fraudulent crypto investing website that promises substantial returns. In many cases, people will continue investing until it becomes clear that their funds cannot be withdrawn.

Fraudsters may claim that they will use an investor's money to buy digital currencies, and then cut off all communication after receiving the funds.

What do animals do in winter?

In winter, animals have to be able to endure frosty temperatures and a decrease in the amount of available food. Here are seven creatures that have adapted and developed strategies to survive the season.

Monarch butterflies - These orange-winged butterflies fly thousands of km to overwinter in Mexico. Even though monarchs can travel between 80 and 160 km a day, this journey takes several months to complete.

Cod - Fish cannot regulate their own body temperature and, consequently, it changes based on the temperature of the water. In order to be able to live in cold water, cod rely on antifreeze proteins. This prevents their blood from freezing.

Hares - In the fall, hares grow a thick, white winter coat. This transformation allows them to stay warm in frigid temperatures and remain camouflaged in the snow.

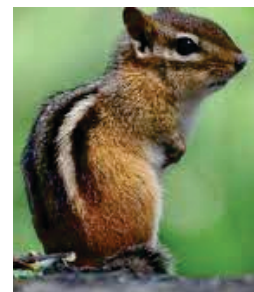
Bees - Bees spend the winter in their hive. When the cold weather hits, the worker bees gather around their queen and vibrate their wing muscles to keep her warm.

Striped chipmunks - These small mammals are true hibernators. They roll up into a small ball and sleep all winter long without leaving their burrow. They slow down their breathing, body temperature and heart rate during this time. Since they expend almost no energy, chipmunks can survive on their fat reserves.

Chickadees - Many birds migrate south when the temperature starts to drop. Chickadees, however, overwinter in some of the coldest northern regions. During this time, they change their diet and eat seeds instead of insects. Moreover, they can puff out their feathers to shelter themselves from the cold.

Bears - Most people assume that bears hibernate all winter. However, this isn't strictly true. In actuality, bears simply lower their metabolic rate and go into a light sleep. Consequently, they may occasionally wake up in winter if they hear a loud noise. Furthermore, female bears have their cubs at this time of the year.

Animals have adapted to cold and snowy winters in many different ways. The unique traits they develop allow them to both stay warm and remain nourished throughout the season.

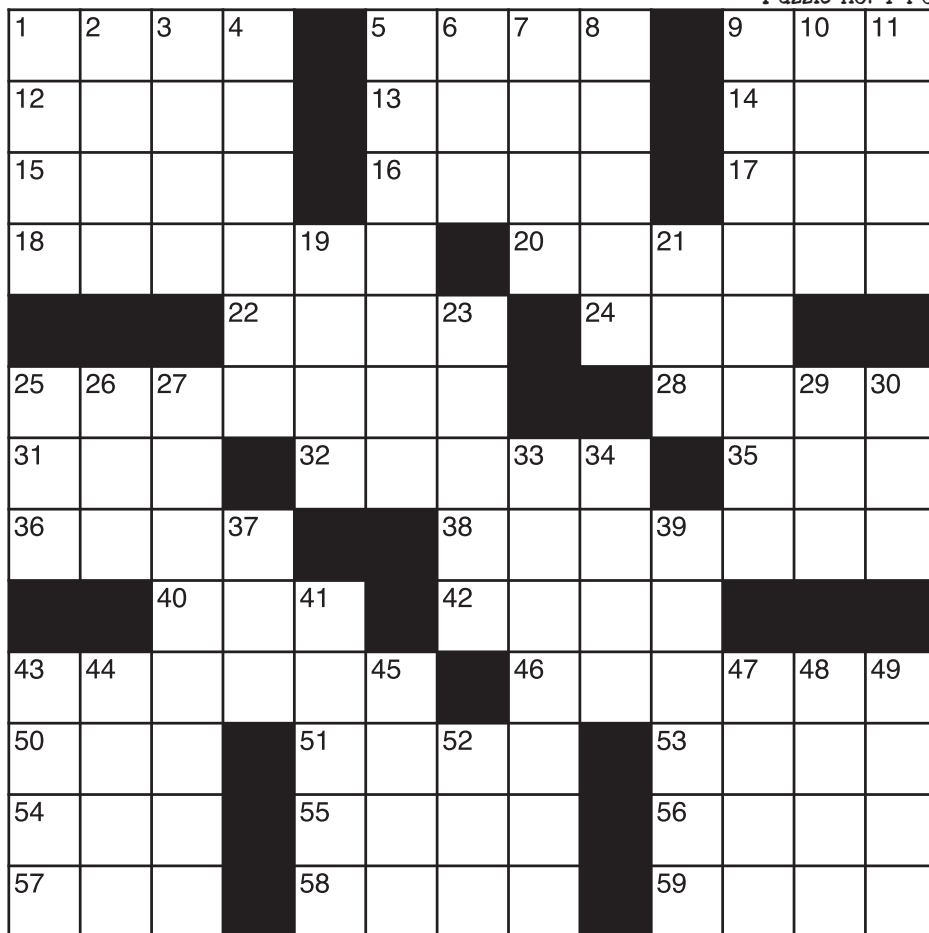

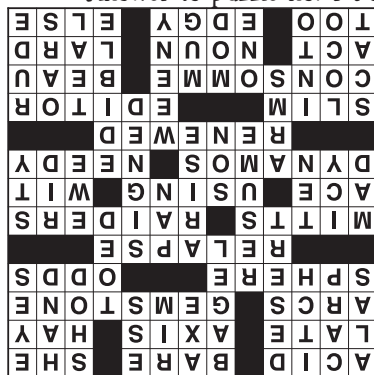

Winter Parking and District Roads Information

Winter is coming and snow removal is always a concern. When removing snow from your property it is required that the snow pile must remain on your property and not be pushed across the roads and onto district property or other private property.

The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens. **Vehicles** parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal may be removed, as regulated in the Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13

A full list of the District of Chetwynd Bylaws can be found on our website at www.gochetwynd.com under the heading Municipal Office/Bylaws and follow the link.

The District of Chetwynd's Snow Clearing Policy, snow plowing will begin after 50mm of snow accumulation, roads will be plowed on a priority basis and residential streets will be plowed within 48 hours following the subsidence of the snowfall. If vehicles are parked on residential streets following a snow fall, the road will not be cleared until all vehicles have been removed and it has been deemed safe by the District.
