GRANDE PRAIRIE MAN IS WANTED IN CONNECTION WITH A FENTANYL SEIZURE

Alberta Law Enforcement Response Team's Grande Prairie organized crime and gang team is on the look out for 22 year old, Justin Myles Stuart. The man is wanted on a warrant for two counts of possession for the purpose of trafficking as well as possession of proceeds from crime.

A search warrant was done on Stuart's home on the 9000 block of 105th Avenue in the Swan City on July 22nd but he was not found. Police seized 423 fentanyl pills, 21 grams of methamphetamine as well as \$1530 in cash proceeds from crime.

During the search, three people were arrested. All three of Laurie Willier, 29, Abel Araya, 34, and Eden Maclean, 22, have been charged with two counts of possession for the purpose of trafficking and possession of proceeds of crime. Araya is also featuring breach charges.

MEET THE MAYOR August 5, 2016

It gives me a great deal of pleasure to provide a snapshot of some of the services, operations, and circumstances that have preoccupied Mayor and Council over the past months. The 2016 Annual Report and the 2015 Financial Report, adopted June 6 are available for your perusal if you are inclined to great bedtime reading – or even if you prefer the shortly after-midnight stimulation of your synapses. You are welcome to ask for a copy. I am sharing with you below excerpts from the Mayor's message in the report.

Each year Mayor and Council, in consultation with Administration, set priorities for use of District resources to maintain and enhance. wherever possible, the services and infrastructure of the District of Chetwynd. The past year has seen many successes which make us happy to be involved. However, there remain many challenges to occupy our time in the coming months.

Last year saw the completion of the Medical Clinic and Wellness Centre and its occupation by Northern Health, and a few weeks before Christmas office staff regrouped in the newly completed and named Chetwynd District Centre. To complement the construction of the clinic, Mayor and Council worked assiduously to recruit and retain medical personnel to serve our needs. Chetwynd, in collaboration with Northern Health, seems to have achieved a measure of success in this endeavour.

There are other successes still to be achieved. Our major industries face the challenge of recruitment and retention. Owner-operator truckers frequently are faced with parking problems. Chetwynd needs to be a truckerfriendly community. Council will be addressing this issue over the next months.

Of a more down-in-earth nature, Chetwynd applied for and received a major Build Canada Grant for construction of a new sewage facility. We expect to bring that project to completion within this construction season.

Then there is the ordinary: the street repair, the paving, the progress on the boulevard walking path, exchanging over-mature trees for new trees, and other projects. In all the things that contribute to a liveable community, Council is active behind the scenes providing policy guidance to Administration.

While we are cognizant of the prosperity that industry brings to our community, we are also very much aware of its close connection to the world economy with its ups and downs and sideways. The decisions made in Saudi Arabia on the price of oil, for example, have affected the viability of retail outlets in our home town. We continue to watch the world scene as it affects us here in Chetwynd. For the time being, lumber prices are supporting a functioning forest industry and we are encouraged by the number of jobs forestry provides in Chetwynd.

We expect that the months ahead will present challenges yet not on the radar. Mayor and Council are committed to providing an environment in which these challenges will be met with clarity of thought and appropriate



August is the month of wild berries in Northern BC, and with the fantastic weather we have had this summer I'm sure there are an abundance of tasty treats hiding, if you know where to find them. Not only are berries a great source of vitamins and antioxidants, they also have several other health benefits. From weight loss to disease prevention, these tasty little morsels can do wonders for you, in addition your already healthy diet.

Studies have proven that berries keep you mentally sharp with learning and memory. They are a perfect snack for those with diabetes, as they also contain a healthy fibre. Additionally, berries have been proven to prevent heart disease in those that have a consistent diet including berries and other fruit and vegetables.

We have a fair selection of different berries which I myself and my

family have picked all around Chetwynd, including: raspberries, red and black huckleberries, saskatoons, wild strawberries, and blueberries. Coming from Abbotsford where we had an over abundance of black berries filling almost every ditch, I had actually never tried a huckleberry or a saskatoon berry until moving here. Although they aren't as sweet as blackberries, the hunt for them is one of the best parts. Who doesn't like cruising down back roads?

Before going to look for your own berries, familiarize yourself with the leaves of the plant, as well as the fruit. Get to know what it looks like throughout the year. This will help you correctly identify edible (and inedible) berries. Wild berries are often less sweet, more intense and slightly "greener" tasting than those that are farmed. They can often taste slightly bitter or sour at first, an acquired taste much like a fine wine.

Wild berries don't grow in the same abundance as those that are commercially farmed. So when you're picking, be sure to leave lots for others, including the wild animals who may depend on

them. Never eat any berries when you can't identify the plant 100%. Learn to identify toxic berries and plants. Most white berries are toxic and should be avoided, as are many dark blue or black-coloured berries. When in doubt, don't eat it.

Not only are berries great fresh, but you can do so many different things with them. Berries may be used in sauces, dressings, pies and cakes. Frozen or fresh, they can be added to a smoothie. Relish what nature

has to offer us while enjoying the scenery of our awesome surroundings.
