BOULEVARD WALKWAY BEAUTIFICATION PLAN



As many have noticed over the past two years, the boulevard trees have been slowly disappearing and being replaced with small saplings. In 2008, the District of Chetwynd commissioned a study that confirmed the trees had surpassed their life span of 45 years. The District began by removing dead limbs, hoping to extend the trees' lifespan, but so many had succumbed to decay, insects and ultimately just time.

They created a plan to beautify the boulevard in 2013 and decided to replace the trees, add lighting, and improve the walking trails by paving them and adding landscaping. Last year, the trees lining the highway between Nicholson Rd and Hwy 29 were the first to see the chainsaw. This year, the majority of trees from the west side of town in front of the new District building have been removed and the remaining trees in that area will be removed within the next few weeks.

The new trees that are being planted are Brandon Elm and Manchurian Ash trees. These species of trees are fast growing, are suited for our weather zone and have a lifespan of 80 years. The District plans to begin planting them in June.

As part of the "Boulevard Walkway Beautification Plan," we have so far seen the addition of a new "Welcome to Chetwynd" sign and landscaped mound at the bottom of Wabi hill lighting along the


trail in front of Rodeo Sub. Within the upcoming months, the next phase of lighting will be complete, lining the path from the Rodeo Sub down to Centurion Creek.


