LAWSUIT AGAINST BC HYDRO OVER **NEW TRANSMISSION LINE**

BC Hydro is facing yet another lawsuit here in the Peace Region, except this one doesn't involve the Site C Dam.

Dawson Creek area rancher Murray Caven is suing BC Hydro over its 230-kilovolt Dawson Creek and Chetwynd Area transmission project, or DCAT line, part of which was erected on his property. According to the Alaska Highway News, Caven and Hydro were in B.C. Supreme Court in Dawson Creek on Monday for the start of what should be a five-day trial. The \$296-million line was built to serve a spike in demand that is driven mostly by oil and gas drilling in the area.

Caven, whose family has lived in the area since 1956, says Hydro did not properly compensate him for lost property value when it expropriated the land. That area is a small corner of a 19-acre parcel that contains Caven's home, a garage and a guest cabin. He runs around 100 head of cattle on 1,000 acres of land. The loss of Caven's land's value is the source of the dispute. He said the 130-foot transmission poles are visible from his house, which is "bracketed" on the other side by a Hydro substation. Hydro gave Caven around \$35,000 for the land. In court, Caven's lawyer argued the sum doesn't begin to cover the loss in property value, which he says was "cut effectively in half" from around \$280,000 to \$140,000. Caven also maintains the construction cut him off from land where he grazes his cattle, which forced him to purchase around \$6,000 in feed. He further claims that contractors damaged a road on his property, to the tune of \$2,800.

Caven, who is listed on the suit along with his mother Agatha, says he knows of two

other expropriation cases set to go before the courts.



New seniors' health action plan to guide Northern Health for next five years

Northern Health has developed an action plan that will provide the framework for the effective delivery of seniors' health services in northern B.C. over the next five years. The seniors' action plan has been derived from the findings of a consultation report on Healthy Aging and Seniors' Wellness released in 2014 and aligns with the Ministry of Health seniors' strategy.

"We know that the seniors' population in northern B.C. is growing more rapidly in proportion to the rest of the province, which has profound implications for the delivery of health services in rural and remote areas," said Darryl Plecas, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Health for Seniors. "The action plan shows it was made for seniors' in northern B.C. by aligning with the Ministry of Health seniors' strategy and Northern Health consultation from last year."

The seniors' action plan outlines three areas of focus, including keeping seniors healthy in their communities through a population health approach, providing integrated primary and community care with early recognition and support for frailty, and taking a rehabilitative approach to providing quality of care in hospital and residential care settings. To best support older adults within Northern Health's resources, the focus of the operational plan will be on health promotion, prevention and community support for healthy aging.

"We are committed to developing initiatives to address healthy aging and seniors' wellness in consultation with key stakeholder groups," said Charles Jago, Chair of Northern Health's Board of Directors. "I am pleased to see that the results of consultations we undertook in 2013/14 have led to the development of a comprehensive strategy that will ensure the provision of services to support healthy aging."

The seniors' action plan has been developed using feedback gathered by Northern Health's Board of Directors in 2013/14 through consultation with seniors and seniors' groups. Consultations were held in communities across northern B.C., with the process involving public sessions, focus groups and First Nations focus groups.

"We need to look at innovative ways to care for our aging population, and this action plan helps with that goal," said Dr. Nicole Ebert. "We want people to be healthy and happy throughout their life, and in partnership with health professionals and communities we can help accomplish that goal."

The seniors' action plan also aligns with the Ministry of Health's seniors' strategy. The strategy places a focus on offering more effective care options in the community to help reduce inappropriate hospitalizations and improve quality of life. The Northern Health seniors' action plan supports this goal.

In addition to the seniors' action plan, a sub-strategy to address end of life and palliative care has also been developed with a



focus on strengthening community based services and a draft dementia care strategy is in the works. These sub-strategies will be used in conjunction with the seniors' action plan to address the needs of northern B.C. residents as they age.

DISTRICT OF CHETWYND COUNCIL HEARS FROM SPECTRA ENERGY AT COUNCIL MEETING

The District of Chetwynd held a regular council meeting the afternoon of October 19th at the Cottonwood Hall in the Chetwynd Rec Center.

Don Hicks, on behalf of Little Prairie Community Forest was very pleased to present a dividend cheque of \$100,000 to the Mayor and Council. This was a major event for the Community Forest.

Talese Shilleto of Spectra Energy made a presentation on the Jackfish Expansion Lake Project. The project plans to add two 36-inch loops between Taylor and Chetwynd. She said local contractors and workers will be employed and that workers will make use of Chetwynd hotels and motels. She also spoke about a second project which is the High Pine Expansion project which plans to add two 42 inch pipeline loops. A third proposed project is called the Wyndwood Pipeline Expansion project which will also add a 36 inch pipeline loop in the Peace.

Rochelle Galbraith filed a report about the trails in the green space and voiced concern about the condition of trees gnawed by beaver. A motion was passed to research the best way to deal with the problem and to report to council with recommendation. Clay Bassendowski also suggested the media help get the public's opinion on how to deal with the problem and warn hikers to stay away from danger trees caused by beavers.

Council also passed a motion to give the Chetwynd Public Library a \$2000 grant for the Young At Heart Christmas Dinner for Seniors.

The next Council Meeting is set to take place Monday November 2nd, 2015.

DAWSON CREEK RCMP RELEASE

Dawson Creek RCMP responded to 192 calls for service during the week of October 11th -17th 2015. Included in the calls for service were 24 driving complaints, 10 motor vehicle collisions, 6 impaired driving investigations, 2 vehicle thefts, 5 break and enters, 9 thefts and 16 suspicious person/vehicle complaints.

Police advise that the subject who made entry into the John Deere dealership and the attempted break and enter at the Dawson Creek Co-op on October 13th, has been identified and is in custody in Fort St. John regarding possession of stolen property in Fort St. John. Police are recommending charges of break and enter, commit theft against the male and an accomplice. Police were unable to recover the stolen lawnmowers which are believed to have been transported to Alberta.

On October 12th 2015, Dawson Creek RCMP responded to a complaint of a break and enter in the 1700 block of 93rd Avenue. A citizen had observed two young females exit a residence and had contacted police. The two youths were located a short distance away from the residence and evidence inside the residence shows that they had damaged property. Police will be recommending charges of break and enter commit mischief against the two 13 year old females.

On October 12th 2015, Dawson Creek RCMP responded to a single vehicle accident on Hwy 97 north. Upon arrival police noted the 27 year old male driver passed out behind the steering wheel with multiple bottles of alcohol scattered about. A roadside test was conducted and the male was suspended from driving for 90 days and his vehicle was impounded for thirty days under the provincial Immediate Roadside Prohibition. The male suffered no injuries as a result of the accident.

On October 16th Dawson Creek RCMP responded to a request for assistance by BC Ambulance service. Police attended and observed a male passed out behind the steering wheel of a vehicle. Police were familiar with the male having had dealings with him the previous evening. The male was displaying visible signs of impairment and was under the influence of narcotics. The 36 year old male was issued a 24 hour driving suspension as a result. The male was transported by ambulance to the hospital for monitoring.


The red 'Remembrance Poppy' has become a familiar emblem of
