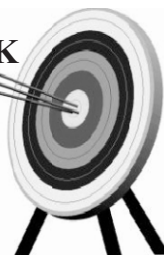

DAWSON CREEK RCMP

Dawson Creek RCMP responded to 184 calls for service during the week of September 6th -12th 2015. Included in the calls for service were 4 break and enters, 4 thefts of property, 18 suspicious persons/vehicle complaints, 20 driving complaints and 10 motor vehicle collisions.

On September 10th 2015, a garage was broken into around the 900 block of 116th avenue in Dawson Creek. A number of power tools and hand tools were stolen. A 44 year old male was arrested in possession of a number of the tools and police have recommended charges of possession of property obtained by crime against the male. He was subsequently released on a promise to appear.

Police would like to thank the public for their assistance in identifying the male who had committed the armed robbery at the George Dawson Inn on August 26th 2015. The male had committed a second armed robbery in the Grande Prairie area a few days later and was observed on video wearing the same clothing as he had worn in the George Dawson Inn robbery. On September 14th Dawson Creek members arrested the 47 year old


male for armed robbery. A hearing was held for the male and he was subsequently released on the Dawson Creek charges. Unfortunately for the male, Grande Prairie RCMP had a warrant issued and extended the warrant to British Columbia which resulted in the male being re arrested and remanded in custody to appear in Grande Prairie to answer to their charges.

This First Nations community is covered by Treaty 8. The community is located at the east end of Moberly Lake, which is about 100km southwest of Fort St. John on Highway 29. There is one reserve, East Moberly Lake No.169, spread over 3025.8 hectares.

SFN is currently accepting resumes for the temporary fulltime position of Acting Director of Family & Social Development. This position is not permanent.

Duties include but are not limited to the following:

1. To provide overall management of AANDC Social Development Programs for Saulteau First Nations and Provincially funded programs, along with various funders.
