BC JOBS PLAN SETS THE STAGE FOR JOB AND ECONOMIC GROWTH IN 2017

The Province of British Columbia finished 2016 with a record number of jobs created, the lowest unemployment rate in Canada, expanded economic activity and increased exports in key market sectors.

With the start of a new year, British Columbia will continue to focus on the long-term goals set out in the BC Jobs Plan, keeping the province diverse, strong and growing.

Since the launch of the BC Jobs Plan in 2011, British Columbia went from third in economic growth to first, expanding by 3.3% (\$7.4 billion) in 2015.

Private sector financial institutions, such as BMO Capital Markets, CIBC, Scotiabank, along with the Conference Board of Canada, are projecting that B.C. will continue to outpace Canada as a whole in 2017 when it comes to job creation, and will either be the leader or near the top of all provinces.

British Columbia set a new record for employment levels in 2016 with over 2.4 million British Columbians working, and has added 191,500 jobs since the launch of jobs plan. At the same time, the province went from ninth in job growth to leading the country with 8.6% job growth.

Of the jobs created since the launch of the jobs plan, over 81% are full-time, and over 96% are in the private sector or self-employed. In addition, British Columbia went from having the fourth-lowest unemployment rate in Canada to currently having the lowest unemployment rate at 5.8%.

Core contributors to B.C.'s economic prosperity are the large-scale construction projects happening throughout the province. The B.C. Major Projects Inventory has \$439.3 billion in major projects with \$78 billion already under construction, an 18% increase over 2011. Of the Province's major taxpayer-supported infrastructure projects in the capital plan, there is more than \$7.5 billion of work taking place in communities throughout B.C. supporting over 38,000 direct and indirect jobs during construction.

B.C.'s exports amounted to \$36 billion in 2015, an overall increase of 10% since 2011. Contributing to those exports are B.C. agrifoods producers who exported \$3.5 billion in products. B.C. forest production exports are up 29% since 2011 and the forestry sector contributed \$7.3 billion to B.C.'s GDP. And manufactured goods account for 67.3 % of B.C.'s total exports to international destinations.

The BC Jobs Plan has achieved and surpassed much of what it set out to do: enable job creation, expand markets for B.C.'s goods and services, and strengthen B.C.'s infrastructure to facilitate the movement of goods to market – while at the same time reducing red tape and other barriers for the province's key sectors.



"Since 1977, we have observed National Non-Smoking Week as one of the longest-running public health events in Canada's history. Each year we take the opportunity to emphasize the importance of quitting smoking, even trying it 'one day at a time' on Weedless Wednesday.

"I know quitting smoking is not easy. Quitting may take practice and it can take a number of times to be successful. Former smokers say they learned something each time they quit. With supports provided through quitnow.ca, there's no better time to get ready to quit.

"We've seen strong success with our BC Smoking Cessation Program, offering eligible B.C. residents free nicotine replacement therapy products when they register at any community pharmacy. Our program now also has more product choices – people trying to quit can choose between nicotine gum, lozenges, an inhaler or the patch, in addition to prescription drugs. I congratulate the 234,500 British Columbians who have used the BC's Smoking Cessation Program to try and quit. As someone who has witnessed loved ones struggle with nicotine addiction, I know your family, friends and pets are immensely grateful for your decision for better health.

"But sometimes offering help is just not enough. Other jurisdictions have explored unique ideas to discourage youth from smoking, like Hawaii and California where they have raised age limits to 21 for buying and selling tobacco. Tobacco is pervasive and attractive, and we need to think outside the box for ways to help limit the number of young people starting to smoke.

"Having a variety of options means people trying to quit will have a better chance of finding a product that works best for them. Together, both the BC Smoking Cessation Program and QuitNow offer the tools they need to quit.

"This year, make a commitment to yourself and your family. Try going smoke-free and reap the rewards of a new, healthier you. Call QuitNow or talk to your pharmacist, and remember that any great journey begins with a single step."

TAKE IT SLOW – LESS IS MORE WITH MODERATION

Through a new social responsibility campaign, the Province is promoting moderation and encouraging responsible alcohol consumption. To help get the word out, all of B.C.'s licensed establishments and liquor retailers are legally required to display these materials in plain view of their clientele.

Education, awareness, and timely information are important tools that help encourage British Columbians to make smart, healthy choices. The new advertising campaign emphasizes moderation when drinking, and builds on the success of the Province's previous campaign encouraging parents to talk openly with their kids in ways that promote resiliency and confidence, and encourage safer drinking. Posters and tent cards will be displayed at every licensed establishment and liquor retailer throughout B.C., in addition to new information and educational resources available to the public at: AlcoholSenseBC.ca

The Province first provided mandatory social responsibility materials to every establishment in B.C. selling liquor in April 2015. To strike a balance between educating the public about the health risks associated with alcohol abuse and reinforcing positive social norms like moderation, the Province worked in collaboration with an advisory committee with representatives from the Centre for Addictions Research of BC, the Provincial Health Officer, the Ministry of Health, the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch, Liquor Distribution Branch, the hospitality industry, and liquor retailers, to develop the new materials.

Although most British Columbians practice moderation while drinking alcohol, those who don't risk causing temporary or permanent damage to their bodies including the liver, stomach, esophagus, intestines, and heart. Binge-drinking is often associated with adverse experiences like vomiting and dehydration, and may increase aggression and violence. Adverse impacts, including dependence, can occur at relatively low levels of consumption. Public health and safety are guiding principles as the Province continues to modernize liquor laws. The mandatory display of social responsibility materials builds on other policies and programs the Province has in place or expanded to protect the health and safety of British Columbians including:

- every establishment in B.C. licensed to sell or serve alcohol is subject to full inspections from the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch to ensure they are in compliance with all public health and safety regulations;
- anyone serving liquor in B.C. is legally required to obtain Serving It Right certification to ensure they understand their legal responsibilities when selling or serving liquor;
- implementing minimum price regulations for all licensed establishments and liquor retailers to ensure that liquor is sold responsibly; and
- using The Minors as Agents Program to help ensure minors cannot access alcohol.

- updated its content to include information about Canada's Low-Risk Drinking Guidelines and tips for avoiding health risks associated with alcohol consumption.




