CHETWYND HOSPITAL CALLS FOR DIVERSION THIS PAST WEEKEND

This past weekend, many Chetwynd residents felt rather uneasy to know that emergency services were not available at our hospital.

For approximately 24 hours between noon Saturday, January 6th through noon Sunday, January 7th, the Chetwynd General Hospital had to divert patients from its



Emergency Room to other medical sites. The "inpatient unit" was full at five admitted patients, another four patients had been admitted into the Emergency Ward and at the time of the diversion, the BC Ambulance arrived at the hospital with another two patients.

Although additional staff were called in, the eleven admitted patients met the capacity and there was insufficient space to treat more patients.

Winter is generally a busy time of year for hospitals, with January being peak season for viruses, but this past month, Chetwynd General Hospital has been at or exceeding term census of 5 admitted patients at all times.

I spoke with Peter Martin, Chetwynd Hospital's Site Manager, who said the diversion is only decided upon in dire situations and to ensure that a highest quality of patient care is maintained.

During the time of the diversion, 911 was still fully operational and patients would

have been taken by BC Ambulance to either Fort St. John or Dawson Creek in the event of an emergency.



FUR-BEARERS ORGANIZATION APPEALING RULING BY B.C. SUPREME COURT

In an update on a previous story, the Association for the Protection of Fur-Bearing Animals plans to appeal the decision made by the B.C. Supreme Court that a Conservation Officer's authority to kill extends beyond what is stated in the Wildlife Act.



Saulteau First Nations (SFN) is a section 10 band within the meaning of the Indian Act. The Band has been formed by the amalgamation of Dunne - Za, Cree, and Saulteau residents. This First Nations community is covered by Treaty 8. The community is located at the east end of Moberly Lake, which is about 100km southwest of Fort St. John on Highway 29. There is one reserve, East Moberly Lake No.169, spread over 3025.8 hectares.

In addition, sections of pipe will be leaving the laydown yard to a nearby construction site. This activity may continue into the first half of 2018.


As a result of this hauling activity, residents can expect increased traffic, which will include large, slow moving vehicles resulting in potential traffic delays.
