

RECEIVED A COVID-19 TEST RESULT? WHAT TO EXPECT

The recent surge in lab-confirmed COVID 19 cases in the Northern Health region is putting pressure on public health case and contact management (contact tracing) resources.

The number of new people testing positive for the virus is impacting public health's ability to quickly contact people who have tested positive. There is currently a backlog of people who have tested positive for COVID-19, but have not yet been contacted by public health.

Northern Health is deploying additional staff to its case and contact management teams, and making other necessary changes to how cases are notified, monitored, and cleared from self-isolation, to clear the backlog and speed up the process in the weeks and months ahead.

Everyone who tests positive for COVID-19 will receive a call as soon as possible from Public Health – this will not change. Northern BC residents who receive a message with a COVID-19 positive test result, should selfisolate immediately, along with those in their household; Public Health will be in contact with you. Rapid options for receiving COVID-19 test results (text or SMS) mean results may come well before a call from public health - which could take up to 4-5 days. We are working to reduce this time frame with additional staffing, and shifting the focus of detailed contact tracing. Currently, contact tracing includes public health identifying and directly notifying all close contacts of every confirmed case. NH is shifting to gathering information on, and notifying, close contacts only in certain situations (including health care workers, including those in long-term care; cases related to industrial projects, and in First Nations communities, and; those that are part of a known cluster or outbreak). This will ensure public health can respond quickly to developing clusters of cases or potential outbreaks for those that are most vulnerable.

Public health will be also be reducing the frequency of calls to people in self isolation after testing positive for COVID-19, and not all people who are self-isolating will receive daily monitoring calls. Individuals may instead receive regular calls from their primary care provider (family doctor or nurse practitioner), or get support by contacting the NH Online (Virtual) Clinic 1-844-645-7811. Public Health will continue to call all COVID-19 positive individuals at the end of their isolation period, to release them from the requirement to selfisolate. As always, Northern BC encourages everyone to adhere to current Provincial guidelines and restrictions. If you are experiencing potential COVID-19 symptoms, we continue to ask that you self-isolate, and contact your primary care provider or the NH COVID-19 Online Clinic and Information Line at 1-844-645-7811. 

More Cleaning Recipes


Toxicity is all around us; people often develop sensitivities to soap, shampoo, household cleaners, lotions, etc. Here are a couple of simple recipes that can be created or modified at home to reduce the amount of chemicals and carcinogens in your own home.

Laundry Soap Recipe: In a quart jar with the lid secured, mix together 2 2/3 cup water, 2/3 cup baking soda and 30 drops of your choice of essential oils (Purification, Thieve's, lavender, peppermint and/or lemon). Remove the lid of the jar and add 2/3 cup of Sal Suds (or most any of Dr. Bronner's liquid castille soap), replace the lid on the quart jar and slowly swirl to mix. To use in laundering-Add 1/4 cup detergent per HE load, 1/2 cup for a regular washing machine load.

Laundry Rinse: 1/2 cup of vinegar in the final rinse cycle acts as a sanitizer, deodorizer and static quard. It will even remove those residual odours of "old clothing" smell, such as what one might encounter in thrift store items. Hanging clothing outside in the sunshine to dry leaves them sanitized and fresh-smelling,

Dandruff and volume shampoo: Blend on high speed—one large onion and two aloe leaves with 1 cup of water on high speed until smooth. Pour into 1 cup of healthy shampoo and let set for two to three weeks. You will be pleasantly surprised at the effectiveness of this safe dandruff control formula that adds volume and a natural shine to your hair.



Winter Parking on District Roads Information **Everyone Should Know**



The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:

(I) in violation of this bylaw; (ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with


(iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.

If you are eligible for the Home Owner Grant and have not claimed the grant for the 2020 taxation year, please apply at our District office before 12:00pm on December 31st, 2020. Home Owner Grants can also be claimed on our District website, under "Apply For", until December 31st, 2020.

You, the homeowner, do not need to make a payment to apply for a Home Owner Grant, but you need to be the principal residing owner of the property.

Your bank may pay your property taxes, however they can't claim your Home Owner Grant. Please ensure you have either claimed the grant or paid the equivalent amount.

As of December 31st, 2020 all outstanding balances in either current taxes or utilities, will be transferred to property taxes to arrears outstanding on January 4th, 2021. Property Taxes in arrears on January 4th, 2021 will be transferred to delinquent taxes. Property taxes in arrears and delinquent will accrue interest at the rate prescribed by the Provincial Government, currently 5.45%. The interest rate is subject to change.

Deadline to pay outstanding delinquent taxes will be September 27th, 2021 by 9:59am; otherwise your property will be sold in the Tax Sale September 27th, 2021 at 10:00am.


